



## AIR NAVIGATION (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER 2015

### THE CARRIAGE OF MUNITIONS OF WAR BY POLICE OFFICERS

#### Exemption 18/2016

1. The Department of Economic Development ("the Department"), in exercise of its powers under Article 156 of the Air Navigation (Isle of Man) Order 2015<sup>1</sup> exempts any aircraft and person from the requirements of Article 70.
2. This Exemption only applies in respect of any munition of war, including CS gas, brought onto an aircraft by an Isle of Man Constabulary police officer in the course of his/her duty after the aircraft has landed within the Isle of Man and which is taken off the aircraft before it next commences a flight.
3. This Exemption has effect unless revoked, suspended or varied.
