It is our intention to replace the worn out track on the Peel Swing Bridge during the week commencing 3rd October.

This is weather dependent and a final decision will be made nearer the time, once forecasts have been issued.

Unfortunately there may be disruption to pedestrian traffic during this week, with the bridge not being available, although there should be no impact on vessels since the bridge will be swung off for the main part of the works.
