IMMIGRATION

THE IMMIGRATION (REGISTRATION WITH POLICE)
(ISLE OF MAN)(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1977

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4(3) of the Immigration Act, 1971 (an Act of Parliament), as extended to the Isle of Man by Order in Council, DO hereby make the following Regulations -

1. Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Registration with Police)(Isle of Man)(Amendment) Regulations 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April, 1977.

2. Registration Certificates

After paragraph (2) of regulation 10 of the Immigration (Registration with Police)(Isle of Man) Regulations 1972 the following paragraph shall be added, namely -

"(3) For a certificate of registration issued to an alien who is not a national of a state which is a member of the European Economic Community a fee of £5.00 shall be paid to the registration officer, except that the fee to be so paid shall be £1.00 for a certificate issued -

- (a) to the wife, where a husband and wife are registered together and neither is such a national as aforesaid; or
- (b) to either spouse, where a husband and wife are registered together and the other spouse is such a national as aforesaid; or
- (c) to a child under 18 years at the time of registration, where he is registered together with a parent (whether or not the parent is such a national as aforesaid); or
- (d) in replacement of one issued previously."
