- 1. You should complete the relevant application form (CEA6) fully and in the applicable sections you should provide all relevant address details to demonstrate cohabitation, such as the address(es) you:
 - Lived together before the date of application (if relevant)
 - Are living together at the date of application
 - Intend to live (if known)
- 2. You must provide four original documents from at least two of the sources below, which demonstrate that you and your cohabiting partner have been, or are living at the same address.

Note: A jointly held document which demonstrates the residence of both of you at the same

address counts as 2 documents: Bank or building society statement Tenancy agreement Mortgage statement Utility bill Driving licence Income Tax return or Tax notification documentation Pay statement House or motor insurance certificate Credit card statement Television licence Local authority rates bill Vehicle registration document Other banking, investment or insurance document Correspondence from any Department or Statutory Board of the Government Correspondence from any other reputable source

3. You must also provide two references from two individuals confirming that you and your partner are living together in a bone fide cohabiting relationship akin to a marriage or civil partnership.

These must include the names, addresses and contact details of those individuals providing the references.
