Key Stage 3 Attainment 2017

The tables and graphs presented here show raw Teacher Assessments at the end of Key Stage 3 (Year 9) in the Island's five secondary schools for 2017. These results are placed into the context of results over the past five years. The results shown include English, Maths and Science and cover the percentage of pupils reaching level 5 and above and level 6 and above at the end of Key Stage 3. At the end of Key Stage 3, the 'expected' attainment level for pupils is level 5.

Schools in the Isle of Man have considerable freedom in their Key Stage 3 curriculum and do not have to follow the National Curriculum for England although the curriculum does need to prepare pupils for their learning in Key Stage 4 (GCSEs, IGCSEs and other Level 1 or 2 Qualifications). Teacher Assessments offer one measure of school and student attainment but they are not to be seen as the only outcome of our schools in Key Stage 3. The Department is committed to developing young people as learners and recognises the enormous range of activities in our schools that support attainment alongside the development of the 6Rs (Readiness, Resourcefulness, Reflectiveness, Resilience, Remembering and Relationships).










Table 5. Percentage of Year 9 reaching Level 5+ in Science




Table 6. Percentage of Year 9 reaching Level 6+ in Science
