A Plan of William Kinrade's property Jurby

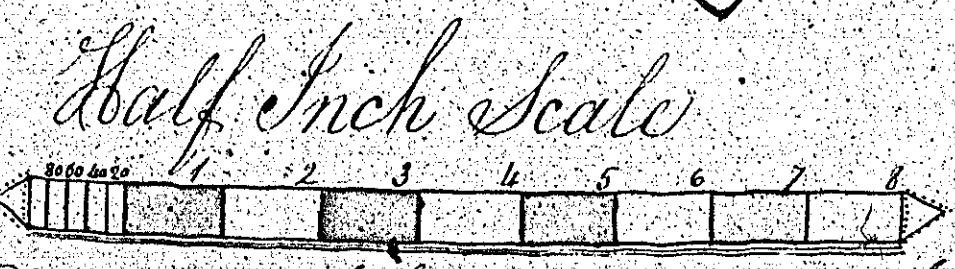
