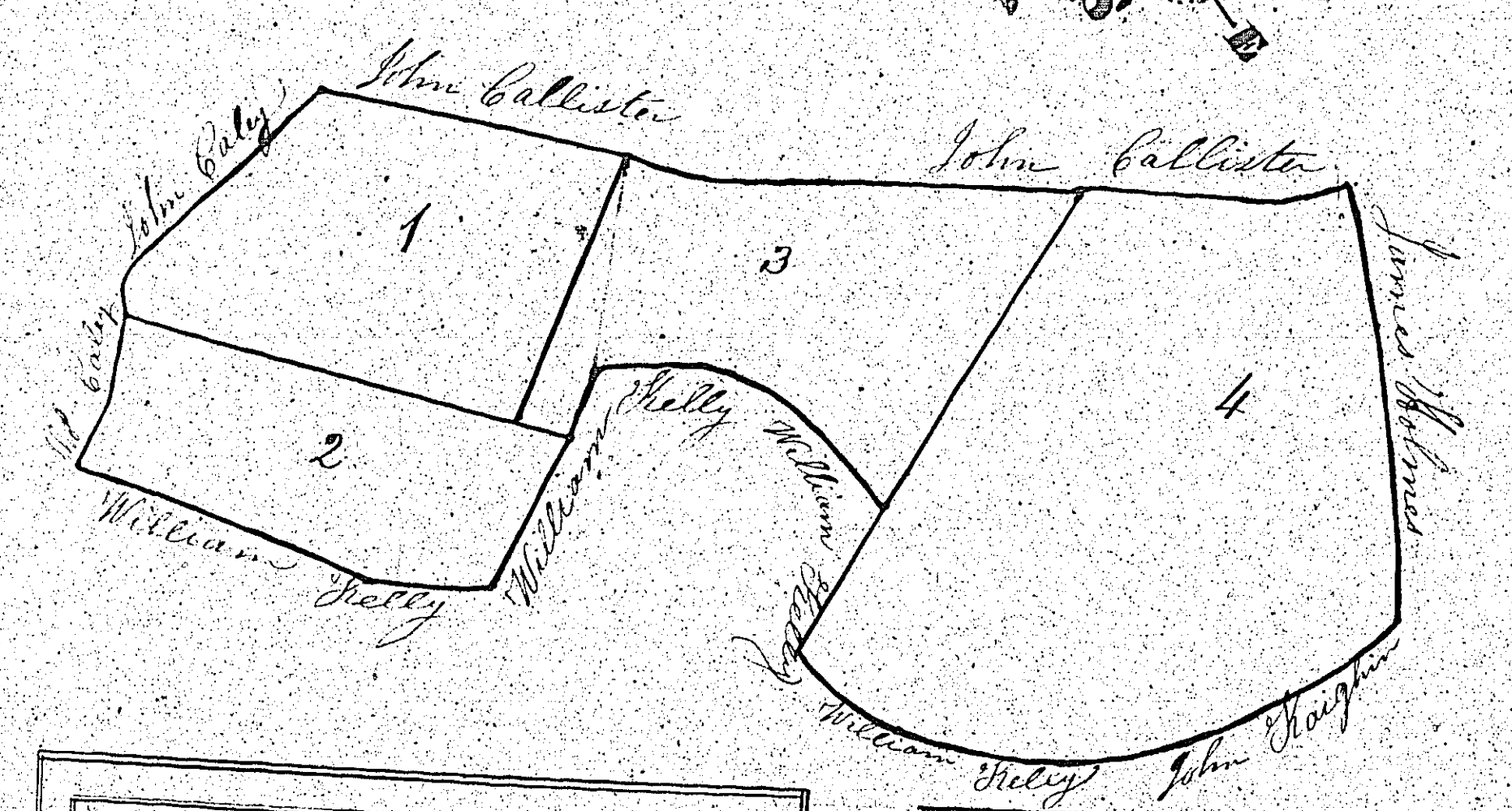


Plan of Thomas Quayles Property July 84.
