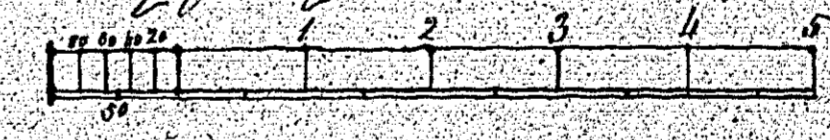

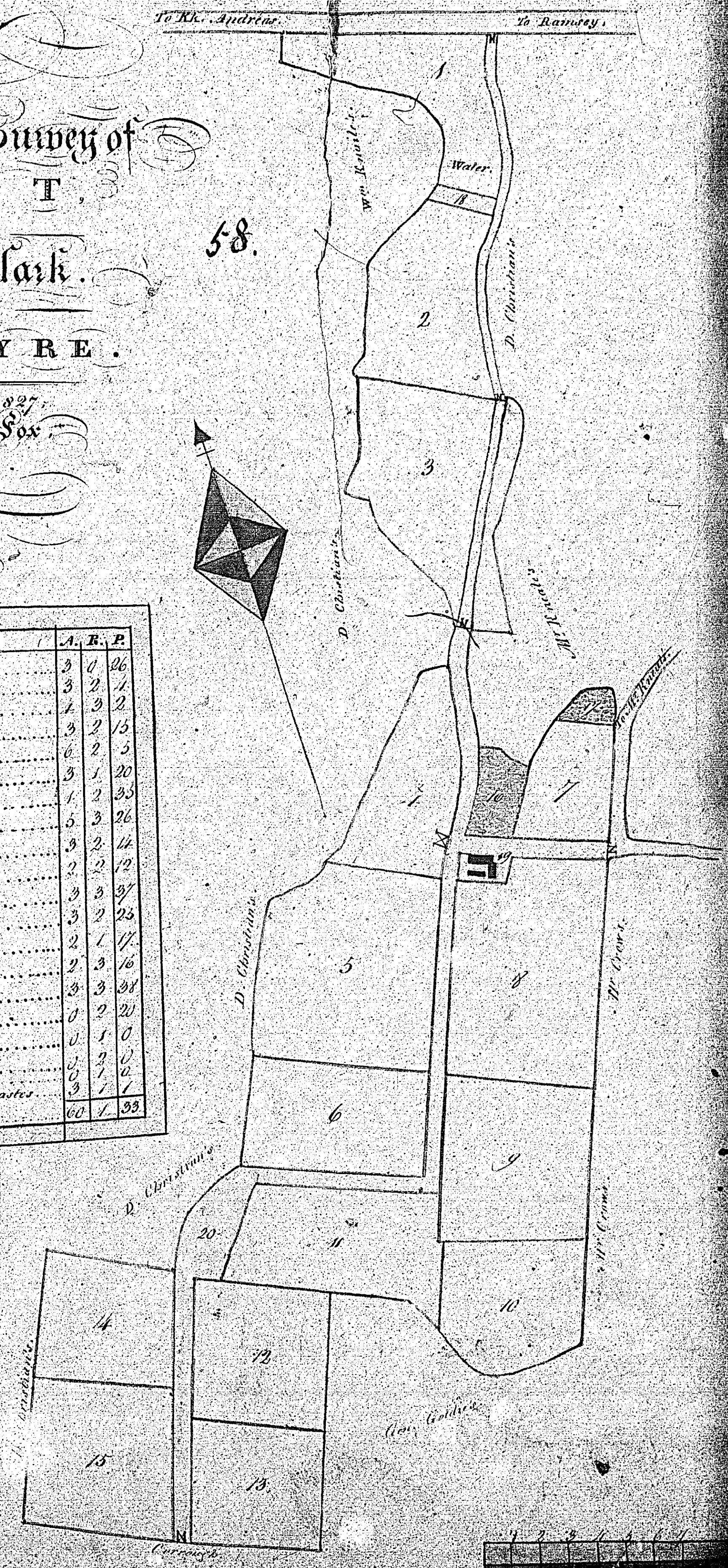

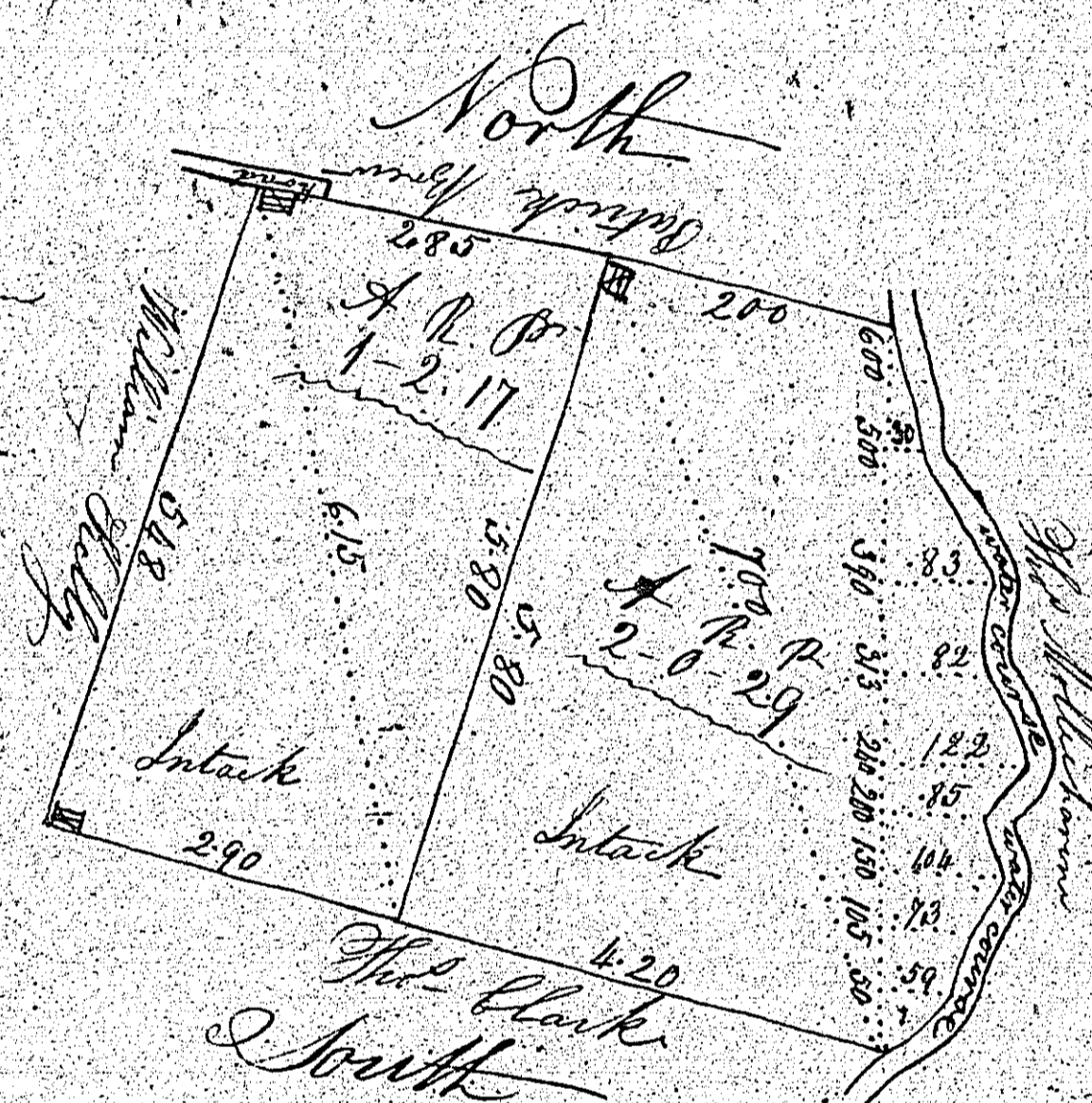
# A Plan of William Clark's Meadows Lesage
