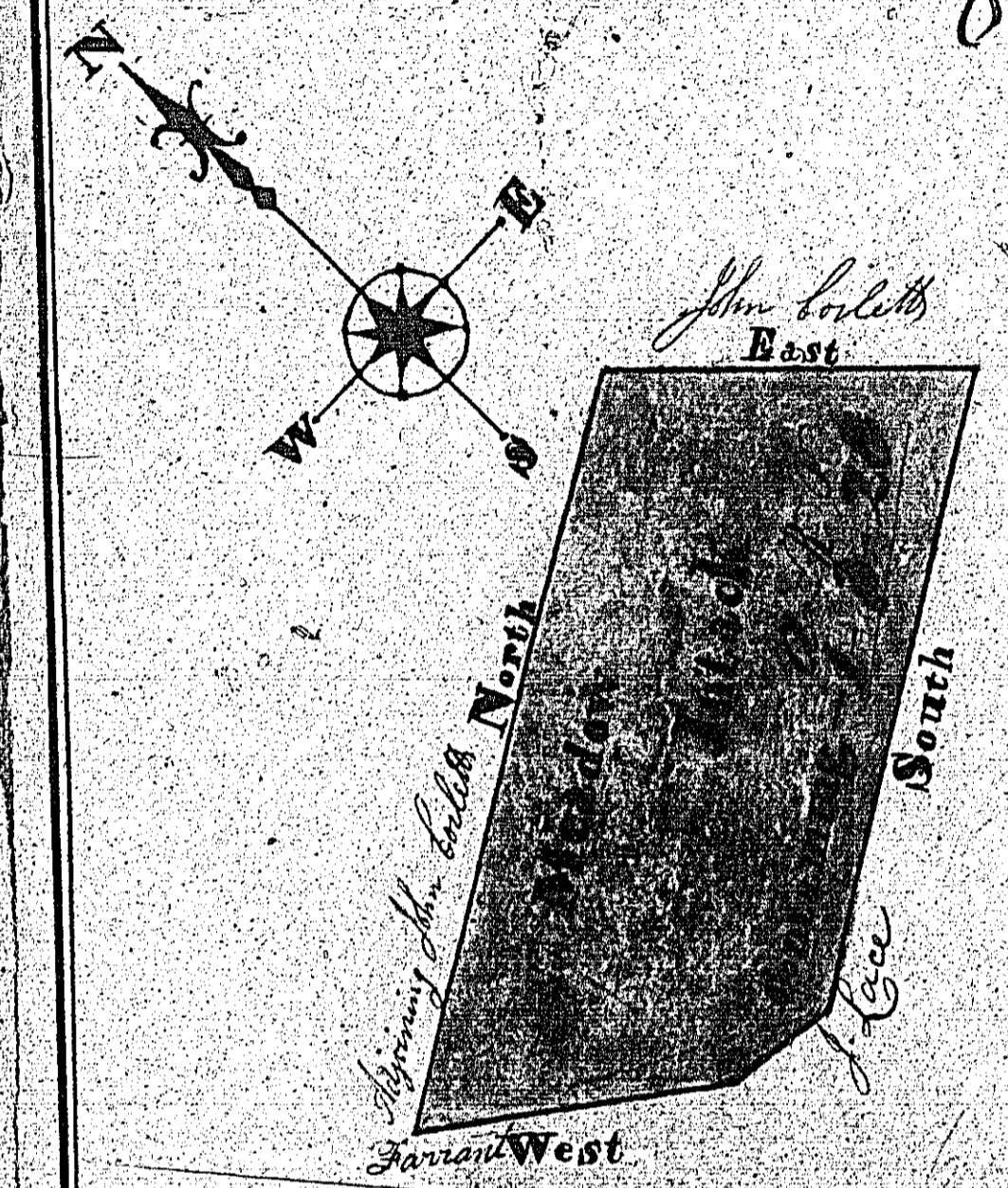

*A Plan of Survey*

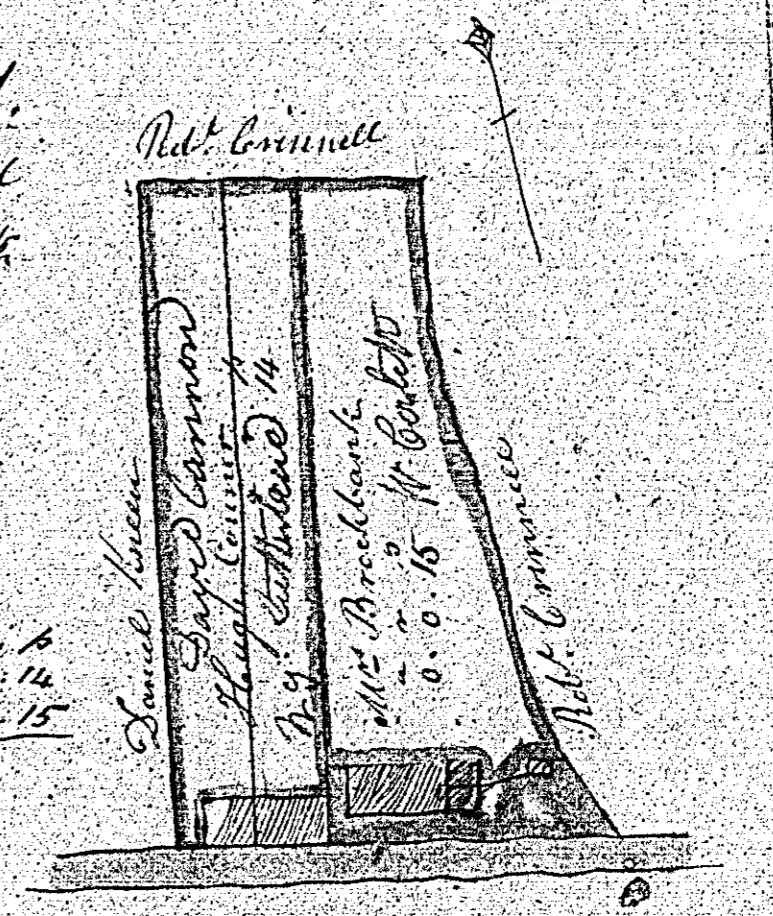
*of the site of the old castle at

Wm. J. Brown, June 16th 1879*

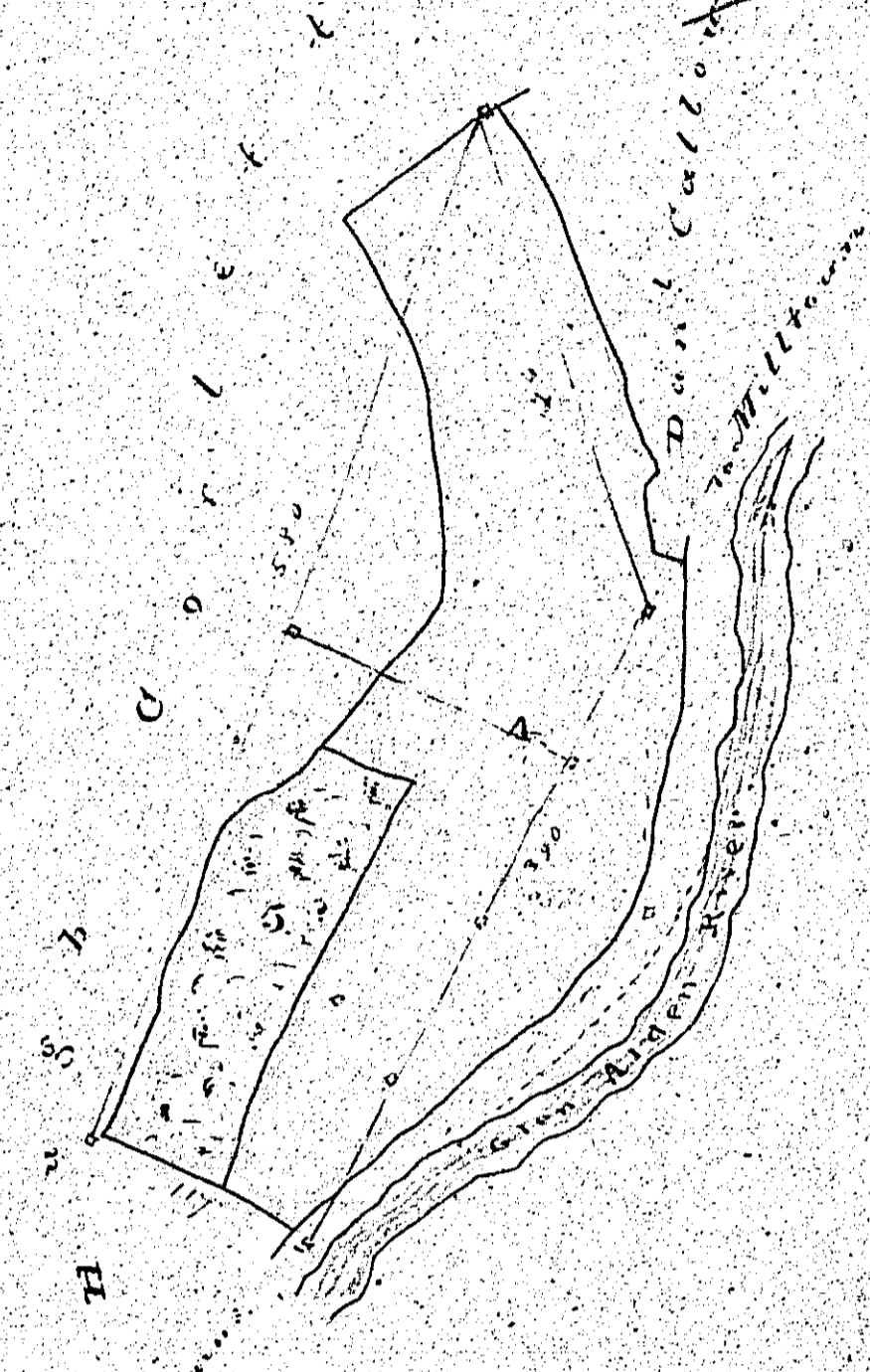
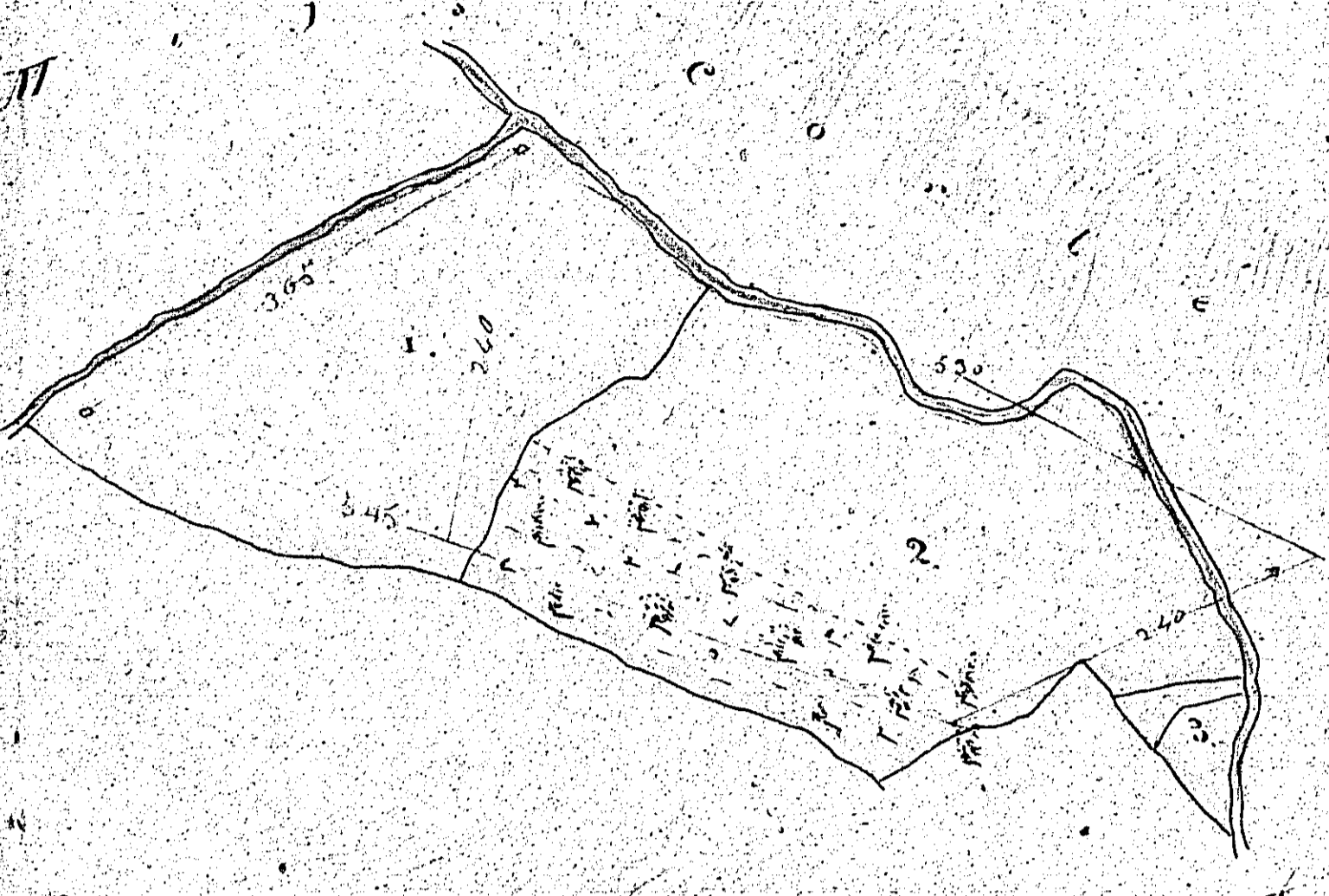
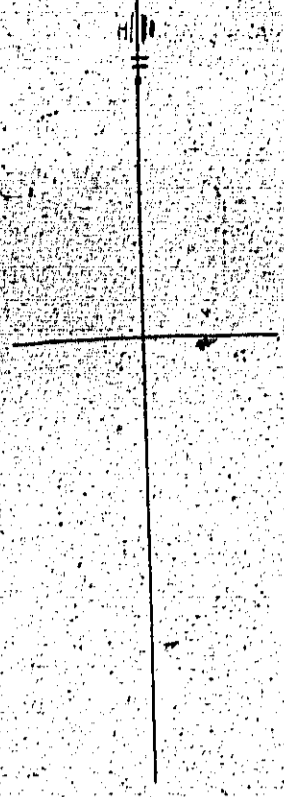
