Focus of visit:

Christmas Night: Reda Moderator assessed this script at 3c with some elements of 3b

Horse Riding : Redact Moderator assessed this script at 3c

General Commentary

- \checkmark Most levels were accurate.
- $\checkmark\,$ Based on the scripts seen, the children appear to be achieving at or above an appropriate level for their NC year.
- $\sqrt{}$ Regular whole school moderation evident
- $\checkmark\,$ Some evidence of scribing / support for pupils who find writing challenging.
- $\sqrt{}$ Assessment sheets use Isle of Man Level descriptors and include 2 sublevels.

NB - these observations are made using the presented scripts for moderation and may not represent the typical performance of the individual year cohorts.

Recommendations:

- $\sqrt{}$ To develop peer and self assessment further
- $\sqrt{}$ To include evidence of Next Steps/ Targets with scripts
- $\sqrt{}$ Consistent use of your level descriptor sheets
- $\sqrt{}$ Consistent use of targets setting using 'I can' statements
- $\sqrt{}$ Consistent use of strategies for marking
