## **Advance Votes**

## How do I apply to vote in advance?

- 1. Fill in the advance vote application form.
- 2. Ordinarily, an advance voter will cast their vote at a place determined by the Returning Officer. If you are unable to do so, you must give a reason, for example you may be housebound. If you will be outside the Isle of Man prior to and on polling day, you must give an address in the British Islands for the ballot paper to be sent to you. Please note: you cannot cast your vote outside the British Islands.
- 3. Make sure you complete all sections of the form. If you are unable to sign this form, please contact your Returning Officer.

Return your form as soon as possible to the Returning Officer for your constituency.

## Voting at a place determined by the Returning Officer

- 1. If your application is approved you will be contacted to make an appointment to attend a specified venue to complete your ballot paper.
- 2. **Please ensure you bring with you a valid form of photographic identification.** If you do not have a valid form of identification please contact your Returning Officer.

### Voting at home

- 1. If your application is approved, you will be contacted to make an appointment for a Certifying Officer to attend your home for you to complete your ballot paper.
- 2. **Please ensure you have a valid form of photographic identification**. If you do not have a valid form of identification please contact your Returning Officer.

#### Voting else where in the British Islands

- 1. If your application is approved, your ballot paper will be posted to the address supplied on this form.
- 2. Please follow the instructions included with your ballot paper.

Note: Once your application has been approved, you will not be able to vote at the polling station on polling day.
