

Civil Aviation (Rules of the Air) Order 2021 General Exemption 2021/038

Landing and Taking Off Near Open-Air Assemblies

- 1. The Department for Enterprise ('the Department'), in exercise of its powers under Article 9 of the Civil Aviation (Rules of the Air) Order 2021¹, exempts any aircraft from the requirement to comply with Rule 3(2) of Schedule 1 to the Civil Aviation (Rules of the Air) Order 2021 ('The Rules of the Air 2021') subject to the condition in paragraph 2.
- 2. The condition specified in paragraph 1 is that the aircraft must not land or take off within 1,000 metres of an organised, open-air assembly of more than 1,000 persons except:
 - (a) at an aerodrome, in accordance with procedures notified by the CAA; or
 - (b) at a landing site which is not an aerodrome, in accordance with procedures notified by the CAA and with the written permission of the organiser of the assembly.
- 3. This permission has effect from **01 August 2021** until it is revoked.
