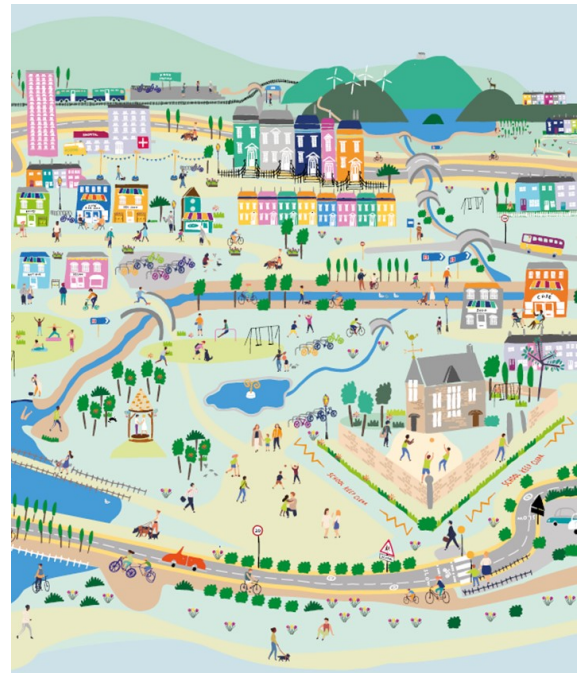

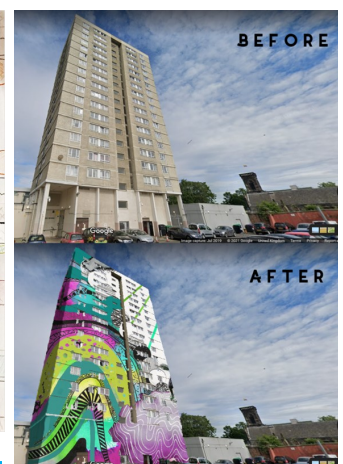
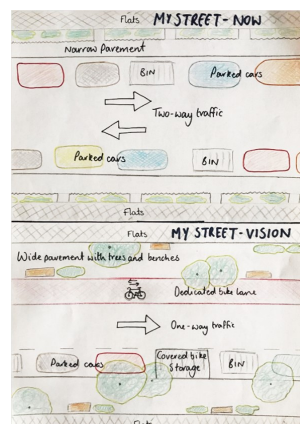
The prize for the winning street or neighbourhood vision will be a voucher (to the value of £150) for a **brand new scooter** from Eurocycles!
