These suggestions were briefly discussed and it was decided to circulate a redacted version of the correspondence to CAG members in order to have a more detailed discussion at the next CAG meeting. Following on from this LH circulated a notice from JW that has been circulated on social media regarding visitors planning a trip to the Island to ride or drive the Green Lanes. The group all agreed it was a good message from JW. LH asked the group to contact JW should they have any further input. SG commented the need to make maps visible/supply for sale on the boat again and if the new boat can supply wi-fi. RC advised the need for a re-run of the Green

	SC commented on organised walking groups and where we can put a structure in place to keep them on designated paths to stop disputes with landowners. It was noted that all organised groups have their own insurance/liability and are liable for any mishaps. GW commented there is a large dog walking business and DEFA do make sure they are properly insured. SC commented on the risk to landowners and their stock; SC meeting with the Blue Badge Group and will provide them with fact sheets etc to make them aware and prevent anything going wrong.YH to introduce the appointed Walking Champion for DfE to SC. GW to discuss the matter further with SC and provide more information on legal implications.

	RC commented on Restriction on Green Lanes 4WD and adhering to the permit system on liability and landowner side.
