


The below charts show the index levels of the components of CPI - this gives an indication of the absolute price level, rather than the year-on-year growth. (100 = Jan 2008)
















Quarterly Change in Jobs







Footfall counting is undertaken in Douglas Town Centre by Douglas Borough Council at three locations: Granville St, Castle St, and Regent St.














Air Passenger Departures






Sea Passenger Departures







Air and Sea % Share (Passenger Departures)




Estimated Visitor % Share (SEA ONLY)



Year-to-date Totals (Air and Sea)





Changes to Avg Claims by Benefit Type








Vacancies - Finance Agency




Vacancies - Digital Agency




Dashboard comparison with labour market report

The below charts are included for comparative purposes to show the differences between the figures reported in this dashboard for jobseekers and vacancies as compared to the official report produced monthly by Statistics Isle of Man.



The Official Jobseeker rate is reported monthly. The Dashboard Jobseeker rate is reported weekly, leading to small discrepancies between the two.

Official Vacancy rate vs Dashboard



The Official Vacancy rate does not include jobs advertised by employment agencies / recruiters. The DfE estimate involves a manual process to add in these vacancies to the overall figure, and the removal of duplicate entries (for example where multiple Agencies advertise the same role). As roles are not given unique flags in the system, this requires an element of judgement.
