[011/22] Declarations of interest or conflict

It was noted that both JB and JW work for the Isle of Man Children's

[012/22] Minutes of the meeting of 13<sup>th</sup> April 2022

Minutes of the meeting dated 13<sup>th</sup> April 2022 were agreed and will be signed by the Minister.

The Education Council Members voted unanimously to include names/initials rather than titles in the minutes of all future Education Council Meetings.

[013/22] Matters arising – Review of action points from the meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2022

The following matters were discussed:

**Terms of Reference** 

It was agreed that EH would discuss with the Head of Legislation and Policy Development and provide an update at the next meeting.

**Education Council Members Training** 

The on boarding process for new Education Council Members was discussed.

CG stated that a list of mandatory training sessions and dates should be included as part of the on boarding process.

This was discussed and it was decided that the Department would look to put together a list of mandatory training for Education Council Members

PW asked if members could complete training online. The Chief Executive Officer confirmed that this would be considered, and provide online channels for training courses for the Education Council members.

#### **Clarification of Governance**

CG requested that the most up to date version of the Isle of Man Government's Code of Conduct would be uploaded to the Education EH Council MS Teams Channel.

CG noted that the Department does not have an External Conflicts of Interest Policy and asked if this is something that could be reviewed.

The Chief Executive Officer noted this and would look into this.

Following discussion of governors meetings it was agreed that a standing agenda would be created for governors meetings in order to have consistency across all school governing bodies.

There was discussion over what data would be shared with the Education Council. The Minister stated that the Education Council should be seeing an overview from schools monthly at governors EH meetings and all information received should be standard across the board. It was noted that this item should be included in the standing agenda for governors meetings.

It was decided that a sub committee consisting of the Chief Executive Officer and a number of members from the council would be formed to discuss what data is shared with the Education Council. EH will arrange this. It was agreed that the Chief Executive Officer would provide an update at the next Education Council meeting following this subcommittee meeting.

# [015/22] Education Council views concerning the needs of public education

The Education Council had a discussion over the amendments to the Education Act. It was noted that two amendment bills would be put forward to Tynwald. The first in 2023 and the second in 2024.

# [016/22] School issues to be raised with the Department

#### **AEN students**

KQ stated that excellence in schools stretches to all students including those with additional needs.

The AEN Code was discussed and it was noted that funding would be an issue for this.

The Minister requested that the Department's fully inclusive policy be **EH** shared to the Education Council MS team's channel.

#### Childcare Strategy

The Education Council discussed the Childcare strategy.

CG asked if parenting skills classes were currently on offer within schools.

JB confirmed that there are third sector organisations that work with schools to provide these classes. A conflict of interest was noted for JW and JB as one of these organisations is the Children's Centre.

This was discussed and it was decided that the Department would look to see which 3<sup>rd</sup> parties provide classes of this sort within school and confirm if these classes are offered across the board.

#### **Department updates**

The Chief Executive Officer provided an update on Freedom of Information and Data Subject Access requests.

The Chief Executive Officer provided an update on the Quality Assurance Task and Finish Group. It was noted that the Quality Assurance Framework would be implemented by a phased approach in

schools from September 2022. It was agreed that the framework would be posted and shared on the Education Council MS Teams Channel.

The Chief Executive Officer provided an update on the task and finish group for Governing Bodies.

#### [017/22] Any other business

#### a) Health and Safety (H&S) Training in Schools

LF stated that the teachers at one of his schools had not received H&S training.

Minister Edge confirmed that every school has a designated body responsible for H&S and that this person will have received the appropriate training.

Following discussion it was agreed that Education Council Member's should receive H&S training in order to be fully informed when carrying out H&S inspections around schools. It was agreed that this would be arranged for the next academic year.

It was noted that H&S should be a mandatory item on all Governing Body's meeting agendas.

#### b) Website

It was noted that JW is not listed as an Education Council Member on the Government Website. EH will amend this.
