## **SOCIAL SECURITY LEGISLATION (CONTRIBUTIONS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2024**

*Approved by Tynwald:* 20 February 2024  
*Coming into Operation:* 6 April 2024

The Treasury makes the following Order under section 141 of the Social Security Administration Act 1992 (of Parliament)<sup>1</sup> as applied to the Island<sup>2</sup>.

### **1 Title**

This Order is the Social Security Legislation (Contributions) (Amendment) Order 2024.

### **2 Commencement**

If approved by Tynwald<sup>3</sup>, this Order comes into operation on 6 April 2024 and shall have effect in respect of the income tax year commencing 6 April 2024 and all subsequent years.

### **3 Amendment of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992 as applied to the Island**

- (1) The Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992 (of Parliament)<sup>4</sup>, as applied to the Island<sup>5</sup>, is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 11 (Liability for Class 2 contributions) —
  - (a) in subsection (1), for “£5.70”, substitute **£6.20**;

- (b) in subsection (4), for “£7,540”, substitute **£8,320**.
- (3) In section 13(1) (Class 3 contributions), for “£17.45” substitute **£18.95**.
- (4) In section 15(3) (Class 4 contributions) —
  - (a) in paragraph (a) —
    - (i) for “£7,540”, substitute **£8,320**;
    - (ii) for “£44,928”, substitute **£48,776**;
  - (b) in paragraph (b), for “£44,928”, substitute **£48,776**.
- (5) In section 18 (Class 4 contributions recoverable under regulations) —
  - (a) for “£7,540”, in each place where it appears, substitute **£8,320**;
  - (b) for “£44,928”, in each place where it appears, substitute **£48,776**.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE*

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends Part I of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992, as it is applied to the Island, by -

- increasing the amount of Class 2 contributions to £6.20 per week;
- increasing the small earnings exception level to £8,320;
- increasing the amount of Class 3 contributions to £18.95 per week;
- increasing the Class 4 lower and upper profit limits to £8,320 and £48,776 respectively.
