AN ACT

to amend the Minerals Act 1986; and for connected purposes.

- 1 [Amends section 2 of the Minerals Act 1986 as follows: paragraph (a)(i) substitutes in subsection (2) the word 'department' for the words 'Board of Tynwald'; paragraph (a)(ii) inserts in subsection (2) the words 'department or' after the words 'Crown or'; paragraph (b)(i) substitutes in subsection (3) the words '4 weeks' for the words '3 months'; paragraph (b)(ii) substitutes in subsection (3)(b) the word 'department' for the words 'Board of Tynwald'; paragraph (c)(i) substitutes in subsection (4) the words '4 weeks' for the words '2 months'; paragraph (c)(ii) repeals in subsection (4) the words from 'or such longer' to the end; paragraph (d) repeals in subsection (5) the words ', in addition to any compensation which is or may become payable under sections 19, 20 and 21, '; and paragraph (e) adds subsections (6), (7), (8) and (9).]
- 2 [Amends section 3 of the Minerals Act 1986 by repealing the words ', with the concurrence of the Treasury, '.]
- 3 [Inserts section 7A in the Minerals Act 1986.]
- 4 [Amends section 16 of the Minerals Act 1986 as follows: paragraph (a) repeals in subsection (6) the words ', in addition to any compensation which is or may become payable under sections 19, 20 and 21, ' ; and paragraph (b) adds subsections (7), (8) and (9).]
- 5 (1) [Amends section 8 of the Minerals Act 1986 as follows: paragraph (a) inserts '(1)' at the beginning; and paragraph (b) adds subsections (2), (3),

(4) and (5).]

(2) [Amends section 9 of the Minerals Act 1986 as follows: paragraph (a) inserts '(1)' at the beginning; paragraph (b) substitutes the words 'sections 7 and 11(3) to (7)' for the words 'sections 7 and 11'; and paragraph (c) adds subsections (2), (3) and (4).]

6 [Amends section 11 of the Minerals Act 1986 as follows: paragraph (a)(i) substitutes in subsection (1) the words '4 weeks' for the words '3 months'; paragraph (a)(ii) substitutes in subsection (1)(b) the word 'department' for the words 'Board of Tynwald'; paragraph (b) inserts subsection (1A); paragraph (c)(i) substitutes in subsection (2) the words '4 weeks' for the words '2 months'; paragraph (c)(ii) repeals in subsection (2) the words 'or such longer' to the end; paragraph (d) substitutes subsections (3), (3A), (3B) and (3C) for subsection (3); paragraph (e) repeals in subsection (4) the words ', in addition to any compensation which is or may become payable under sections 19, 20 and 21,'; and paragraph (f) adds subsections (5), (6) and (7).]

7 [Amends section 25 of the Minerals Act 1986 by substituting subsection (4).]

8 [Inserts section 25A in the Minerals Act 1986.]

9 [Amends section 26 of the Minerals Act 1986, as follows: paragraph (a) inserts subsection (1A); and paragraph (b) substitutes subsection (2).]

10 [Amends section 29 of the Minerals Act 2006 as follows: paragraph (a) substitutes subsection (1)(b); paragraph (b) substitutes in subsection (2) the words '15 metres' for the words 'fifty feet'; and paragraph (c) substitutes in subsection (8)(b) the words '15 metres' for the words 'fifty feet'.]

11 [Inserts section 29A in the Minerals Act 1986.]

12 [Amends section 30(3) of the Minerals Act 1986 by substituting paragraph (m).]

13 [Inserts section 32A in the Minerals Act 1986.]

14 [Repeals the Sand and Gravel Pits Regulation Act 1968.]

15 **Short title and commencement**

(1) This Act may be cited as the Minerals (Amendment) Act 2006 and the Minerals Act 1986 and this Act shall be cited together as the Minerals Acts 1986 to 2006.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on such day as may be appointed by order made by the Department of Trade and Industry and different days may be so appointed for different purposes and for different provisions.
