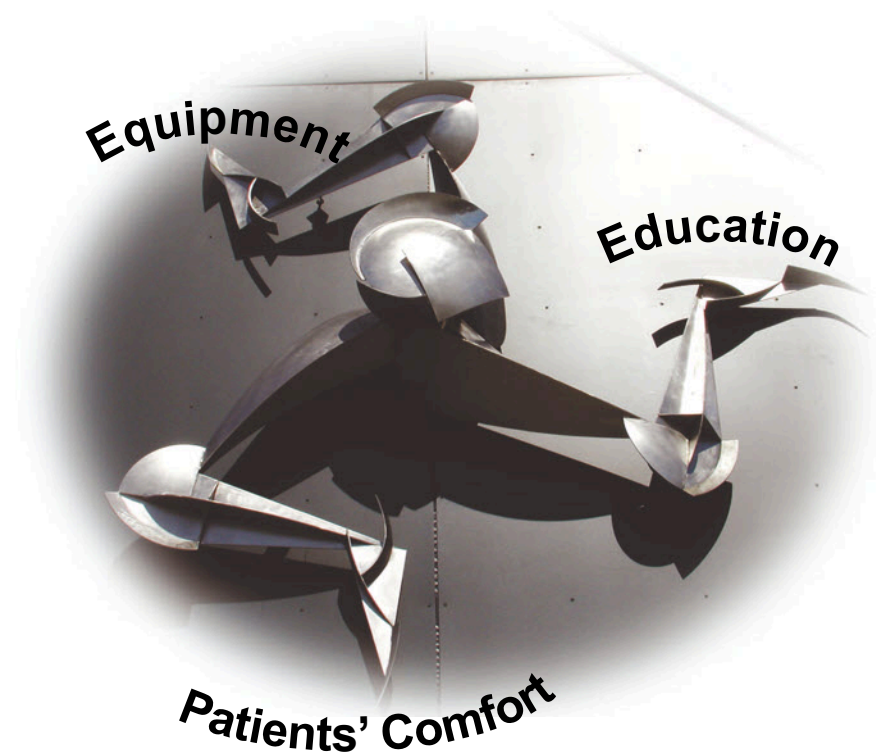

About us

The Trusts were formed in 2006 to administer the large number of donations and legacies made during the lifetime of the hospital on the Westmoreland Road site. Many of these funds were of relatively small sums and it was thought that by bringing them together in three groups, more efficient use could be made of the money whilst at the same time meeting the wishes of the donors. All of the Noble's Hospital Trusts are registered charities.



Your donated monies are kept separate from the day-to-day Government funding and are used to improve the environment and services for all patients and staff of Noble's Hospital in a manner that may not necessarily be achieved using tax payer's money.

With this ethos in mind, individual Wards and Departments do not have specific charitable funds but draw their funding from the three Charitable Trusts listed in this leaflet.

This allows greater flexibility and access by all the Wards and Departments and ensures your donations are held and administered in a fair and safe way.

There are three separate charities, one for each area of spending that is most appropriate to improve the environment and services in Noble's Hospital.

Meet the Trustees

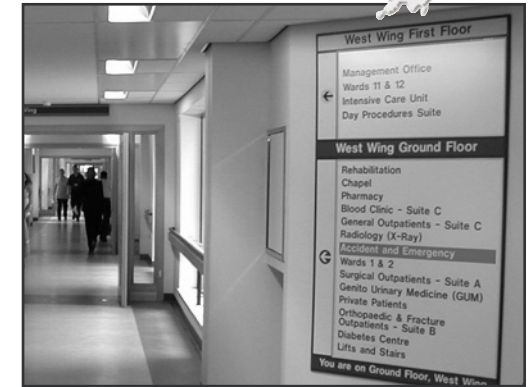

Patients' Comfort

The Noble's Hospital Patients' Comfort Trust

Registered Charity No. 948

This fund is available to all Wards and Departments for any acceptable charitable application to improve the well-being of patients whilst in hospital.



Hospital Equipment



The Noble's Hospital Equipment Trust

Registered Charity No. 947

This fund is available to all Wards and Departments, and provides funding for equipment for use throughout the hospital.

Education

The Noble's Hospital Education Trust

Registered Charity No. 949

This fund is available to all Wards and Departments, and provides funding for the training and education of all staff including course fees, education material, etc.
