

Payment by Bank Transfer - Land and Deeds Services

All services provided by the Deeds, Probate and Land Registries can be paid for by electronic bank transfer (BACS) using the details set out below.

All payment made by BACS must have a reference pre-fixed with the letters 'LD' to enable us to identify the payment from the many received by DfE, thereby enabling us to deal with your request in a timely manner.

Depending on which service you are paying for, the reference should be completed as follows:

To pay to register a deed – please note payment must be made in advance. Please add, after the prefix, the first line of the address to which the deed relates (for example, 'LD 161 Park Road').

If paying for multiple deeds, it is acceptable to enter the number of deeds (for example, 'LD 6 deeds').

To pay for a land application - please add the application number after the prefix (for example, 'LD 202009999').

Purchasing Office Copies or survey map extracts – please add either the Title number (for example, 'LD 13-09789') or, if there is no Title number, the first line of the address to which the request relates.

Multiple services – payment for any combination of the above can be made in the one payment. Please state the reference 'LD Multiple'.

With the exception of land applications submitted electronically in advance of payment being made, a note should accompany any application/request confirming that payment has been made by BACS. The note should clearly state the date the Bank was requested to make the payment, the amount and the reference given.

Where a BACS payment is received without a full reference ('LD' and some further reference as set out above), the payment will be returned to the originating bank without any further investigation or enquiries being made by our staff.
