

THE ADOPTION ACT 1984

THE ADOPTION (BIRTH RECORDS) REGULATIONS 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Clerk of the Rolls by section 39 of the Adoption Act 1984(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made: -

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Adoption (Birth Records) Regulations 1985 and, subject to section 53 of the Act, shall come into operation on the 1st January 1986.
- In these Regulations "the Act" means the Adoption (2) Act 1984.

Application for birth information

- (1) For the purposes of section 39(1) of the Act, the adopted person shall apply to the Chief Registrar
 - where the person was adopted before the 1st January 1986, in form 1 in the Schedule;
 - where the person was adopted on or after the 1st January 1986, in form 2 in the Schedule.

Application for verification in connection with intended marriage

For the purposes of section 39(2) of the Act, the adopted person shall apply to the Chief Registrar in form 3 in the Schedule.
