Coming into operation 9th August 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Local Government and the Environment by section 12 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1991<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Advisory Council on Planning and the Environment and the Douglas Corporation, the following Order is hereby made:-

#### 1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Douglas Promenades Conservation Area Order 2002 and shall come into operation on the 9<sup>th</sup> August 2002.

# 2. Designation of conservation area

The area in the borough of Douglas defined by the outer edge of the thick black line on the plan hereto annexed and marked "Map referred to in the Douglas Promenades Conservation Area Order 2002" is designated as a conservation area.
