THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1999

THE KIRK MICHAEL CONSERVATION AREA ORDER 2006

Coming into operation on the 1st August 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Local Government and the Environment by section 18 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1999¹, and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Commissioners of the local authority district of Michael, the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Kirk Michael Conservation Area Order 2006 and shall come into operation on the 1st August 2006.

2. Designation of conservation area

The area in the local authority district of Michael defined by the outer edge of the thick black line on the plan hereto annexed and marked "Map referred to in the Kirk Michael Conservation Area Order 2006" is designated as a conservation area.

EXPLANATORY NOTE (This note is not part of the Order)

This Order recognises an area within the local Authority district of Michael centred on Kirk Michael Village, and delineated on the accompanying map, as an area of special architectural or historic interest, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance: such area is designated as a Conservation Area.

The special character of the area is described and set out in a written Character Assessment, which whilst not part of the Order, would be published by the Department in a Planning Circular to be read in conjunction with the map of the Conservation Area.
