Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

LONG OR HEAVY VEHICLES (DESIGNATED ROADS) ORDER 2015

Laid before Tynwald: Coming into Operation:

1 January 2016

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 after complying with paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to that Act.

1 Title

This Order is the Long or Heavy Vehicles (Designated Roads) Order 2015.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 1 January 2016.

3 Interpretation

In this Order "articulated vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Road Vehicles (Maintenance and Use) Regulations 2012.

4 Application

This Order applies to -

- (a) an articulated vehicle (not falling within sub-paragraph (b)) the length of which exceeds 14 metres;
- (b) an articulated vehicle the laden weight of which exceeds 32520 kg but does not exceed 44000 kg.

5 Prohibition on use of roads

(1) No person may, without the consent of the Department of Infrastructure or except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, use or cause to be used a vehicle to which this Order applies —



- (a) on a road mentioned in paragraph (2) except for the purpose of loading or unloading goods; or
- (b) on any other road except a road designated in the Schedule for use by such a vehicle.
- (2) A road to which paragraph (1)(a) refers is
 - (a) so much of Market Street as is not specified in the Schedule; or
 - (b) Nelson Street, Thomas Street or Victoria Street,

being roads in Douglas.

6 Saving

Nothing in this Order affects any prohibition or restriction imposed otherwise than by this Order.

7 Revocation

The Long or Heavy Vehicles (Designated Roads) Order 2014¹ is revoked.




EXPLANATORY NOTE
