

Claim for a TV Licence Payment

What is a TV Licence Payment?

A TV Licence payment is a payment made to certain people to cover the full cost of their TV Licence.

Who can get a TV Licence Payment?

You can get a TV Licence payment if you or your partner have reached state pension age but not age 75 and one of you is getting either Income Support or Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance because you are on a low income.

"Partner" means your husband, wife, civil partner or someone else living with you as if you were married to them.

You might also qualify for a TV Licence payment if you or your partner have reached state pension age but not age 75, and you used to get Income Support or Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance but no longer do so and you have received a TV Licence payment in the past. How to claim a TV Licence payment

Please provide the information requested overleaf and then take or send this form with your TV Licence renewal notice - or your new TV Licence if you have already paid for it - to -

Income Support (Pensioners) Team, Social Security Division, Markwell House, Market Street, Douglas, IM1 2RZ.

When can I claim a TV Licence payment?

You can make your claim up to 1 month before the date the TV Licence fee is payable and up to 2 months after that date. For example, if your TV Licence is due for renewal on 1 February 2019 you can claim your TV Licence payment at any time between 1 January 2019 and 31 March 2019.

How will a TV Licence payment be paid?

Your TV Licence payment will normally be paid in the same way as your State Pension is paid to you.
