REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2014

Made: 18 December 2014
Coming into Operation: 5 January 2015

The Clerk of the Rolls makes the following Regulations under section 43(1) of the Civil Registration Act 1984¹.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Regulations 2014.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 5 January 2015.

3 Amendment of the Registration of Births and Deaths Regulations 2011

The Registration of Births and Deaths Regulations 2011² are amended as follows.

4 Regulation 16 (re-registration of birth) amended

- (1) Regulation 16 is amended as follows.
- (2) In paragraph (2) omit “, before the expiration of 3 months from the date of the birth,”.
- (3) In paragraph (3) omit “before the expiration of 3 months from the date of the birth”.

5 Regulation 53 (correction of minor clerical errors after completion) amended

- (1) Regulation 53 is amended as follows.

(2) In paragraph (3)(a) omit “or superintendent registrar”.

6 Regulation 54 (correction of other minor clerical errors after completion) amended

(1) Regulation 54 is amended as follows.

(2) In paragraph (1) after “live-births” insert “or deaths”.

7 Regulation 55 (correction of other clerical after completion) amended

(1) Regulation 55 is amended as follows.

(2) In the heading after “clerical” insert “errors”.

(3) In paragraph (3) for “Registrar General” substitute “Chief Registrar”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Registration of Births and Deaths Regulations 2011.

The amendment made to regulation 16 removes the time limit under which the mother and/or father are required to give information to the registrar in order to re-register the birth of their non-marital child (in accordance with section 13 of the Civil Registration Act 1984).

The amendments made to regulations 53, 54 and 55 correct original drafting errors.
