IMMIGRATION

The Immigration (Revocation of Employment
Restrictions)(Isle of Man) Order 1972

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 3(3)(a) and 4(1) read with section 34(1), (2) and (3) of the Immigration Act 1971 (an Act of Parliament) as extended to the Isle of Man by Order in Council, DO hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Revocation of Employment Restrictions) (Isle of Man) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1973.
2. In this Order "the Regulations" means the Aliens Regulations 1959 as amended.
3. (1) Any employment restriction which, by virtue of section 34(3) of the Immigration Act 1971 (an Act of Parliament), as extended to the Isle of Man by Order in Council, applies to an alien who is a national of a state which is a member of the European Economic Community is hereby revoked.
 - (2) In this Article "employment restriction" means -
 - (a) any landing condition imposed under Regulation 5 of the Regulations or any condition treated as a landing condition so imposed by virtue of Regulation 6 of those Regulations;
 - (b) any restriction imposed by any Order made under Regulation 22 of the Regulations; or
 - (c) any restriction imposed by virtue of paragraph 3 of Schedule 1 to the Regulations,

which prohibits an alien from or imposes restrictions on taking employment or engaging in any occupation in the Isle of Man.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order revokes any restrictions on taking employment or engaging in any occupation in the Isle of Man imposed on an alien under the Aliens Regulations 1959 and still in force on 1st January 1973, if the alien is a national of a state which is a member of the European Economic Community.
