The Draft Isle of Man Strategic Plan 2015 with Modifications

The Isle of Man Strategic Plan was approved by Tynwald in 2007. The Plan sets out the Department's general policies for the development and use of land across the Isle of Man. In December 2013, the Department began the process of reviewing the Isle of Man Strategic Plan 2007 in line with the procedures set out in Schedule 1 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1999. The Preliminary Publicity took place between 6th December 2013 and 31st January 2014 and this sought views on the Department's intention to carry out a focused Review. Following consideration of the responses to the Preliminary Publicity, the Department kept the Review tightly focused and published the Draft Isle of Man Strategic Plan 2015 on 16th January 2015.

The Draft Plan identified proposed changes to: the Island's broad housing need figures and Plan period (Housing Policy 1 and Strategic Policy 11), the spatial distribution of those figures across the North, South, East and West of the Island (Housing Policy 3), and some of the text as consequential amendments.

In terms of the content of the Draft Isle of Man Strategic Plan 2015, it incorporated much of the Isle of Man Strategic Plan 2007 and the general layout remained largely the same; the Plan simply went through a timely roll forward to bring key figures up to date. By reviewing the 2007 Plan in this way, the Department's view was that it could start to prepare the remaining Area Plans in an expeditious manner, starting with the Area Plan for the East. As the Department has stressed throughout the review process, it is through such Area Plans that: existing land designations can be reviewed, additional land can be designated for development where needed, and other detailed matters specific to local communities and places can be dealt with.

Ahead of the Public Inquiry into the Draft Isle of Man Strategic Plan 2015, a Pre-Inquiry Meeting took place on 23rd July 2015. The Inquiry itself was held between 28th September and 1st October 2015.

In general, the Inspector was supportive of the content of the Draft Plan although there were a number of recommendations which the Department has considered and incorporated into an updated version of the Plan, namely "The Draft Isle of Man Strategic Plan 2015 with Modifications". The Department is now seeking views on the proposed Modifications. The completion of this Form will allow the Department to understand the views of the public (and others) on the Modifications. The Department, in considering the representations made, will make a decision on whether or not to 'Adopt' the Plan and in doing so will produce a 'Department Response Document' which will respond to all of the representations or objections submitted.

Upon 'Adoption', the Plan will then be put to Tynwald for 'Approval.' It is at this stage that the new Isle of Man Strategic Plan will formally replace the Isle of Man Strategic Plan 2007.
