This year has been as busy as ever for the War Memorials Preservation Committee. The Committee remain active and enthusiastic for this cause which has come much more to public prominence throughout the centenary celebrations of World War One, and the 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the end of World War Two.

In addition to the work that we have always done in promoting the preservation of memorials, as well as visiting them and inspecting them, we have expanded our work into researching those who have perished since World War Two so that their loved ones can be contacted to see if they would like assistance in having their service recognised on one of the Island's War Memorials.

From a parliamentary perspective, the War Memorials Bill has started its progress through the legislature. It would, for the first time, give the protection of law to our Island's War Memorials and place a duty of care on the owner of the memorial to maintain it. This has been subject to extensive consultation, and its final fate may not be known until after the summer recess.

I would like to join the Chief Minister in thanking the members of the Committee as well as those who support our work. It is important that the legacy of peace we enjoy today is constantly remembered through the memorials constructed by those they left behind.

## **Introduction**

At the Tynwald sitting in October 2008 approval was given to the establishment of a Body for the Preservation of the Island's War Memorials to be called the Isle of Man Government Preservation of War Memorials Committee ('the Committee').

The Committee is responsible for -

- (a) ensuring a proper registration of War Memorials throughout the Isle of Man;
- (b) encouraging the proper maintenance and upkeep of such Memorials; and
- (c) avoiding the destruction of, or overseeing the removal of, such Memorials by encouraging the owners or custodians to advise the Committee that such is likely prior to such actions being taken so as to enable the Committee to ascertain any actions that may be appropriate for them to safeguard the Memorial.

The establishment of the Committee did not remove the responsibility for War Memorials from Local Authorities.

The Committee is required to produce an Annual Report to be published and made available on the Government Website.

The tenure of the membership of the Committee is at the pleasure of the Council of Ministers and by appointment following every General Election. The current membership is made up as follows:-

## Work Undertaken

- (a) To ensure War Memorials are recognised and cared for in the future, the Committee has compiled a database detailing the War Memorials throughout the Isle of Man which includes the following information–
- location;
  - brief description;
  - photographs showing the War Memorial and its location;
  - (where known) the War, campaign, action or unit commemorated;
  - the date of erection and/or dedication;
  - transcript of inscriptions and names so that a permanent record exists in case of future damage or loss; and
  - (where known) the designer/maker/craftsperson who created the War Memorial.

The Committee continues to update the database which is maintained by Manx National Heritage (‘MNH’) and is available on its digital research facility via the iMuseum Website at: [www.imuseum.im/Subjects/RelatedPlaces.mth?entryid=2896263](http://www.imuseum.im/Subjects/RelatedPlaces.mth?entryid=2896263).

Please see the **Appendix 1** which lists the War Memorial locations, types of Memorial and the responsibility at page 10.

MNH also holds a record of the grid reference, condition reports, historic information and digital mapping. The data is being used for online visitors, teacher training, family history workshops, shared with the Royal British Legion and other online partners.

The Committee has received updates from MNH on its plans to commemorate World War One and has noted that the Cabinet Office has established a Steering Group which is acting as a co-ordinating body for all events being arranged throughout the Island. The Steering Group will continue its work up until November 2018.

- (b) Liaison has continued with The War Memorials Trust, a charity that works for the protection and conservation of War Memorials in the UK and includes the Crown Dependencies in its works. Hannah Murphy, Assistant Curator: Documents and Records, (Tel: 648072 email: [hannah.murphy@mnh.gov.im](mailto:hannah.murphy@mnh.gov.im)) continues her involvement with the Charity as the Isle of Man Liaison Officer for the Charity. Her role and responsibilities include:-
- being the point of contact for queries about the Island’s Memorials;
  - liaising with the Charity;
  - keeping a record of War Memorials in the local area; and
  - ensuring that the Island’s War Memorials have an online presence.
- (c) The Committee has kept a watching brief on planning applications to ensure that checks for the location of War Memorials are undertaken when a planning application is made.

The Planning & Building Control Office has been asked to consider introducing, as a matter of procedure, the practice of notifying the Committee on receipt of applications which include work that may have an effect on a War Memorial.

If members of the public have any concerns about a War Memorial the Committee would appreciate being notified.

- (d) Throughout the year the Committee continued its work and contact with various custodians around the Island to advise on, and encourage, proper maintenance and care of the Island's Memorials.
- (e) The Committee has liaised with various bodies and organisations in order to raise the profile of the Committee and to generate an interest in the preservation of War Memorials within the wider community.
- (f) The Committee was pleased to note that the Department of Infrastructure, had accepted its recommendation to issue the Department for Constitutional Affairs, 'Guidance for Custodians' booklet on War Memorials to all Local Authorities. The Department of Infrastructure has further agreed to ensure that when the "Local Authority handbook" is revised, wording will be included about the preservation of War Memorials which will be circulated to all Local Authorities.
- (g) In February 2014, the Chairman received permission to introduce a Private Member's Bill into the House of Keys for a War Memorials Bill which it is hoped will provide protection for the Memorials. The Bill has been submitted into the Branches.
- (h) Ongoing work to locate families of those who died in service post World War Two in order to contact them and see if we can advise as to how the name of their loved one can be included on a Memorial.

## **Way Forward**

The Committee will continue its work to ensure that the remit determined following the Tynwald Resolution is fulfilled and to seek the support of custodians to maintain their Memorials in good order.

The Committee will continue to build on the close working relationship with MNH, as MNH has similar aims regarding the preservation of War Memorials and there is a mutual benefit from working together to establish a single database which will meet both requirements.

In order to improve the close working relationship between the Committee and the Church Authority, the Committee is delighted that the Council of Ministers has agreed the appointment of The Venerable Andrew Brown, Archdeacon of Man.

The Chairman is progressing the War Memorial Bill through the Branches; the Committee fully supports the Chairman's endeavour to progress this Bill.

## Photograph record

The Committee is establishing a photographic record of Isle of Man War Memorials; please see below two selected examples taken from our record:

**Lezayre Parish War Memorial** – The inscription reads: 'To the glory of God and in memory of the men of the Parish of Lezayre who fell in the Great War 1914-1918.'



**Canadian Airmen's Memorial** - The inscription reads: 'You shared with us the eagle's view, the right to soar, as eagles do, the right to call the clouds our home, and grateful, through your heavens roam.'
