## A Keyll Darree Library Guide

### What is Athens via Scholar?

A nice easy way to check your Athens access using Google Scholar. See straight away if you have access to a resource or not.

Usually when you search via Scholar, your results will display like so:

To add the Athens option click the three bars on the left hand side of the page and select the settings option next to the cog icon.

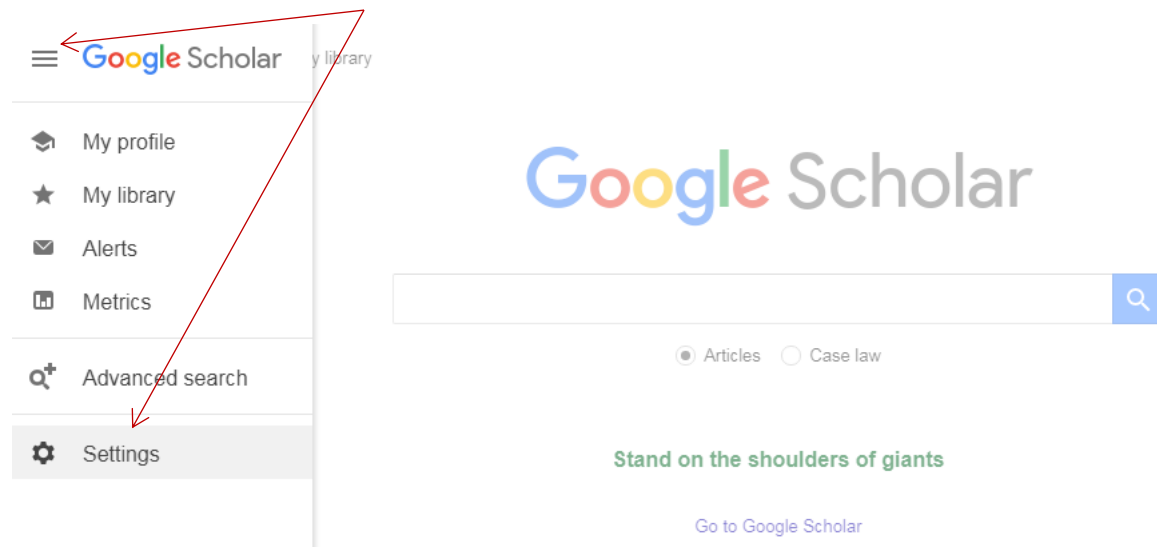


Image description: Screenshot showing the user where to click on the page as described above.

Select "Library Links" from the options on the left hand side of the page.

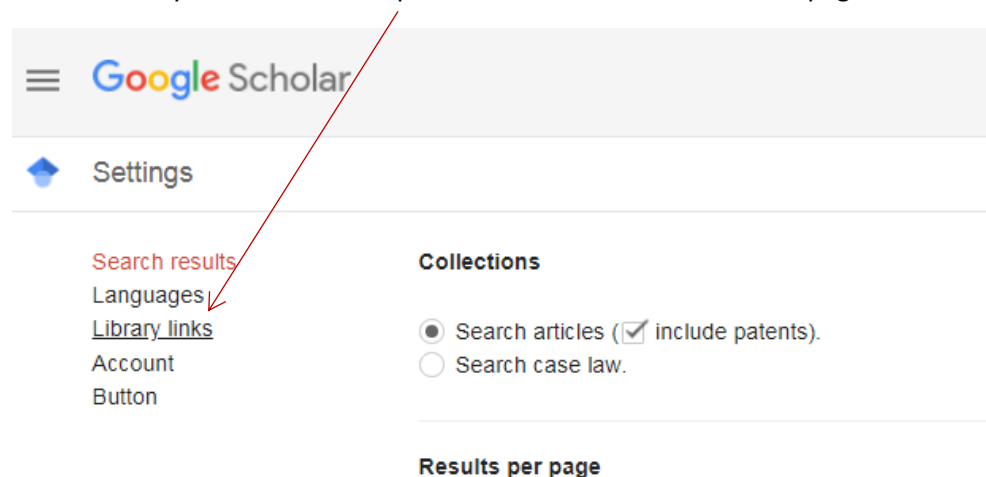


Image description: Screenshot showing the library links option, on the left of the settings page.

You can search for us with "Isle of Man", make sure you tick **NHS ISLE OF MAN** and not Isle of Man – Keyll Darree Library but you can add up to five libraries. Hit the search button and tick the box next to the organisation you want to add.

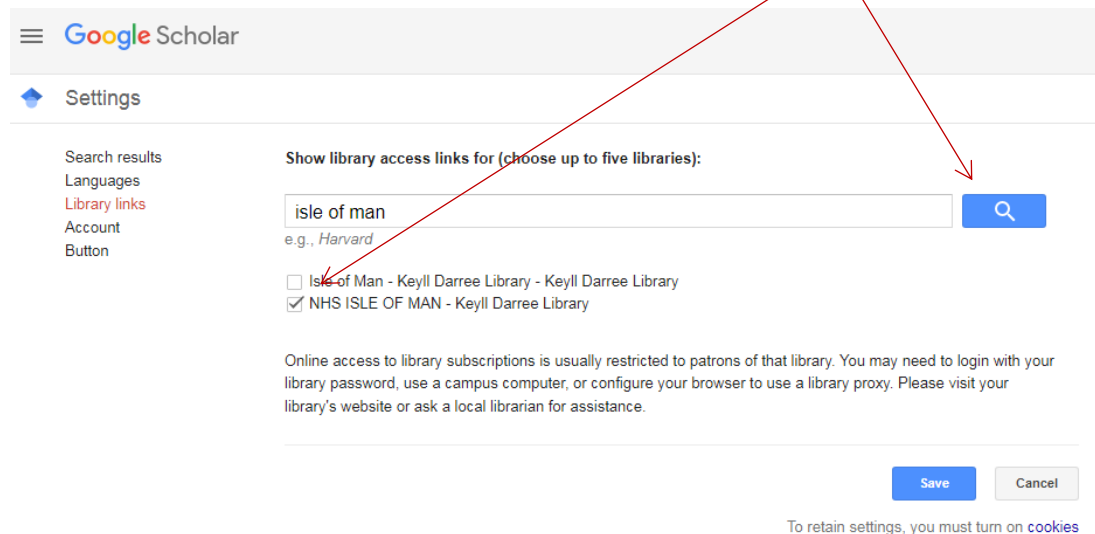


Image description: Screenshot showing the search bar and library results as described above. NHS ISLE OF MAN is the second option.

You will now be able to see if you have access via Athens

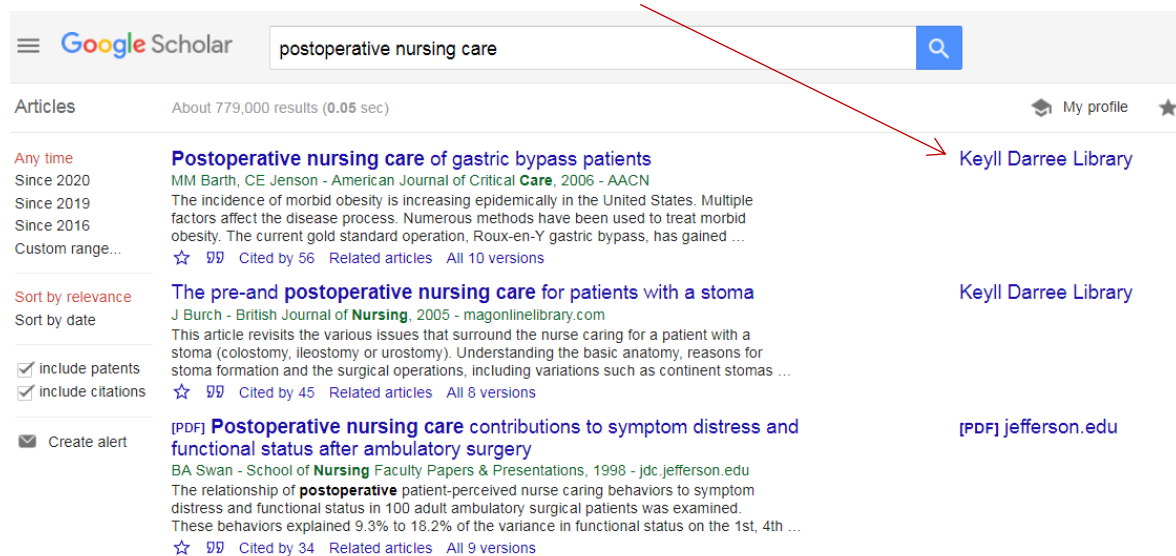


Image description: Screenshot showing the words "Keyll Darree Library" appearing to the right of results where Athens access is available.

Click directly on the library name to view access options.

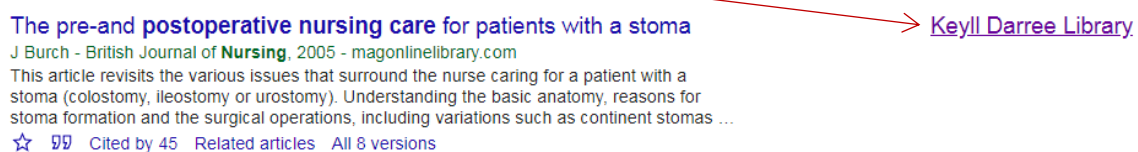


Image description: Screenshot showing users to click directly on "Keyll Darree Library" alongside the required article.

You will then be prompted to log in with your Athens account.




Image description: Screenshot showing the Athens login prompt

And transferred to the article. Click "PDF" to view it.




Image description: Screenshot showing the page which provides full text access to the article. An arrow directs users to click on the PDF icon to the left of the screen.
