Registering a Birth.

All Bovine Births MUST be registered with the Cattle Passport Centre within 7 Days of tagging.

Fill in the relevant details overleaf. Although there is space on this form for up to 4 Birth registrations they need not all be used before returning the form to the Cattle Passport Centre.

If there is not already a cattle passport for an animal and it is required to be moved from the Birth Holding before 28 days of age then a Temporary Calf Passport (form TCP) must be filled out by the keeper and moved with the animal.

Completing this form

- Official Breed Abbreviations are shown on the bottom of this page.
- All Dates should be in the Format day day month month year year.
- The identity of the Genetic Dam (Embryo Donor) must only be filled in if it differs from the Birth Dam.
- The identity of the Sire must be given if known. This must be the official ear tag number, or for A.I. bulls where the tag number is not known the registered pedigree name must be used.
- Ensure the date of completion and Keeper details are filled in before returning the form.
- Incomplete or illegible forms will be returned for suitable completion.
- You will be sent a new Birth Registration form along with your Passports for registering further births.

CROSSBREEDS

If the animal has parents of different breeds it is a crossbred animal. Crossbred animals should be described by the dominant breed characteristics of the animal i.e. What it is most looks like, followed by an **X** for crossbred. Often the animal most resembles the bull, for example a Charolais bull bred with a Holstein cow would produce a calf best described as a Charolais cross which would be abbreviated as **CHX**.

If the animal is descended from many breeds the abbreviations BX for beef cross or CON for continental type should be used.
