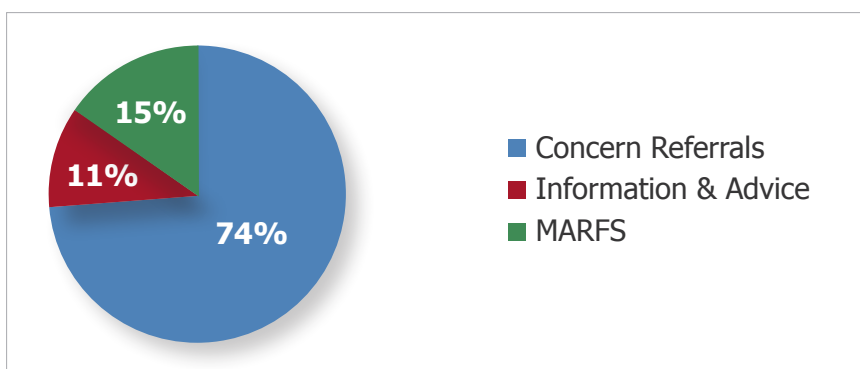


2019/20 Overview: Adult Safeguarding

Adult Safeguarding is covered by the Adult Social Care team who play a central role in protecting and safeguarding the Island’s vulnerable adults. Find below the key adult safeguarding data for the 2019/20 year.

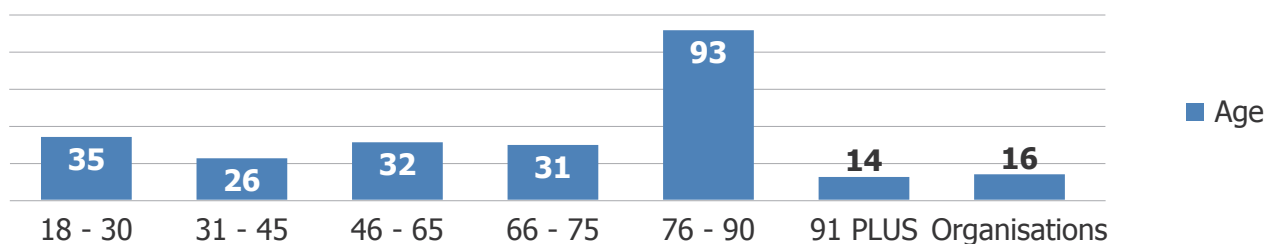
From April 2019 to March 2020 the Adult Safeguarding Team processed in total 386 referrals. Referrals into the Adult Safeguarding Team are split into three different categories, Concern Referrals, Information and Advice and Multi-agency Referral Forms (MARFs).

Referral Reason for Year 2019 - 2020



A total of 247 Concern Referrals were received into the Adult Safeguarding Team in the 2019/20 year. Females made up the majority of the referrals, with 133 referrals compared to 98 referrals for males during the reporting period.

As the Adult Safeguarding Team develops and the ethos of Adult Safeguarding is integrated into the Department’s working practice and culture, individuals are encouraged to contact the team for advice, guidance and signposting.

In the reporting year of 2019 -2020, the Adult Safeguarding Team processed in total 81 Multi Agency Referral Forms (MARFs) which originate from the Isle of Man Constabulary, Public Protection Unit.
