**DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 3 (MEAYLL PENINSULA AND THE CALF
OF MAN)**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Local Government and the Environment by article 3 of the Town and Country Planning (Permitted Development) Order 2005¹, the following Direction is hereby made:-

1. Direction

Being satisfied that none of the operations or changes of use specified in Classes 3 – 38 of Schedule 1 and in Class 7 of Schedule 3 to the Town and Country Planning (Permitted Development) Order 2005 (“the Order”) should be carried out without planning permission in –

the Meayll Peninsula and the Calf of Man

as identified with a thick black line on the Map annexed to this Direction;

the Department directs that article 2 of the Order shall not apply to any such operations or such changes of use within this area.

2. Commencement

This Direction shall take effect on the 21st February 2006.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Direction)

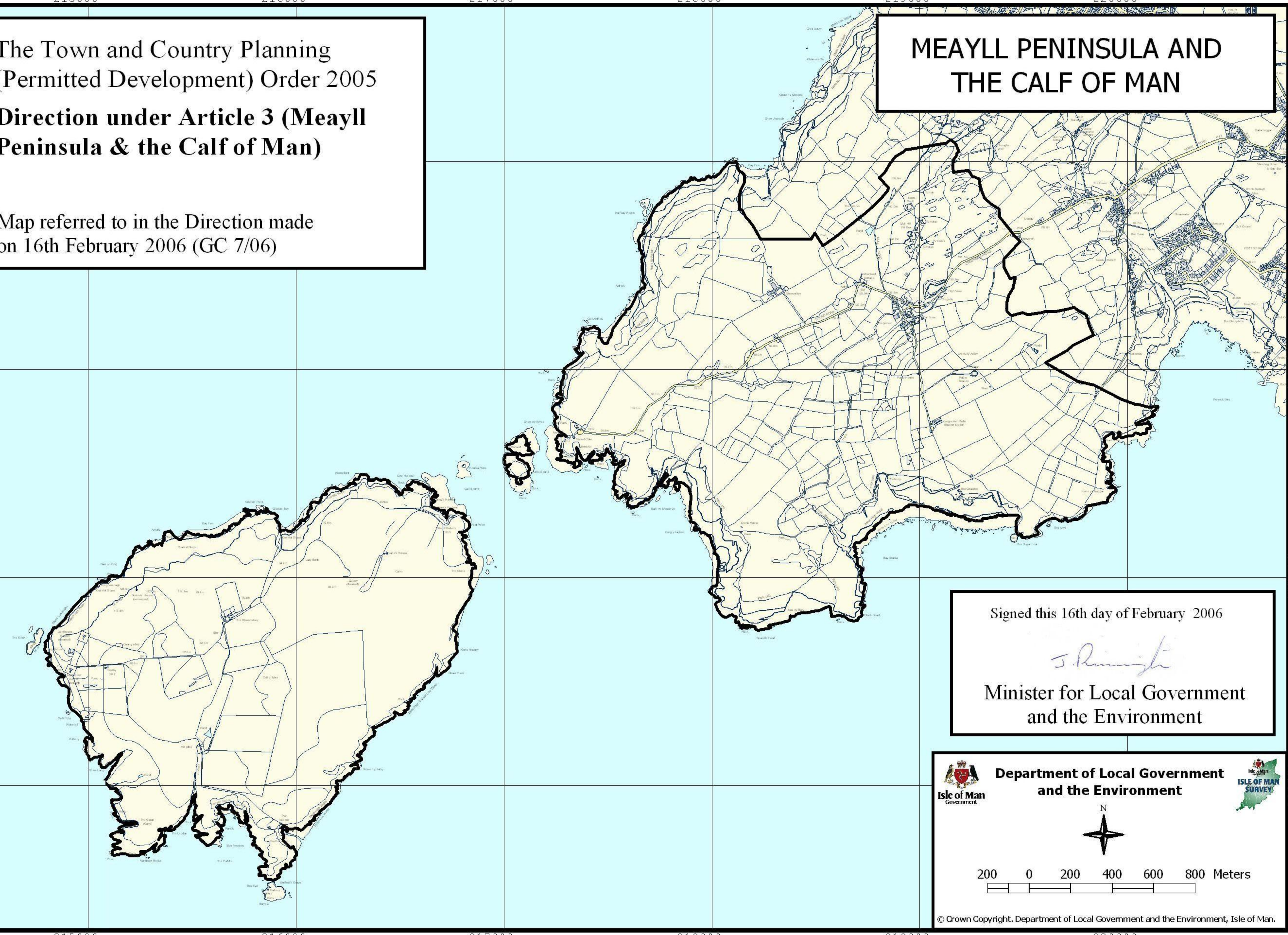
The effect of this Direction is that, within the designated area (the Meayll Peninsula and the Calf of Man), Permitted Development will be limited to repairs to public services, highway works (within the highway), and changes of use which do not involve building operations or afforestation.
