Approval was granted and the memorials were unveiled on 8 April 2021 with a memorable ceremony. A more detailed account with pictures of the new memorials appears later in the report.

1. Introduction

At the Tynwald sitting in October 2008, approval was given to the establishment of a body for the Preservation of the Island's War Memorials to be called the Isle of Man Government Preservation of War Memorials Committee ('the Committee').

The Committee is responsible for -

- (a) ensuring a proper registration of War Memorials throughout the Isle of Man;
- (b) encouraging the proper maintenance and upkeep of such memorials; and
- (c) avoiding the destruction of, or overseeing the removal of, such memorials by encouraging the owners or custodians to advise the Committee that such is likely prior to such actions being taken so as to enable the Committee to ascertain any actions that may be appropriate for them to safeguard the memorial.

The establishment of the Committee did not remove the responsibility for War Memorials from Local Authorities.

The Committee is required to produce an Annual Report to be published and made available on the Government website.

3. Isle of Man War Memorials Register

The Register, compiled by the Committee and maintained by Manx National Heritage ("MNH"), includes the following information:

- location;
- · brief description;
- photographs showing the War Memorial and its location;
- (where known) the war, campaign, action or unit commemorated;
- the date of erection and/or dedication;
- transcript of inscriptions and names so that a permanent record exists in case of future damage or loss; and
- (where known) the designer/maker/craftsperson who created the War Memorial

The Committee has identified and continues to monitor the physical condition and vulnerability to damage of each War Memorial in order to assess the need for conservation works. It was agreed that Manx National Heritage ('MNH') would maintain the register with updates being provided by the Committee.

MNH has responsibility for the care and promotion of Isle of Man's natural and cultural heritage and in March 2021 went live with the new Isle of Man Historic Environment Record database and website: isleofmanher.im ("IOMHER").

The continued collaboration between the Committee and MNH has provided the resources to develop a major research tool for members of the public, commercial operations and academics alike. The Island's War Memorials are given their own section on the IOMHER homepage that includes a single link to all 223 memorials on the interactive map. The two new memorials unveiled this year will be added in due course. Each memorial is marked by its own pin on the map with a link to a list of those commemorated (to which biographies can be added to) as well as links to any relevant items from Manx National Heritage collections, for example a photograph (since digitised) of the memorial when it was unveiled.

A full report, which includes the history of the memorial, current condition, satellite map, and any modern images of the War Memorial is available to view and print.

The MNH record also includes the grid reference, condition report, historic information and digital mapping of the memorials. To search for War Memorials visit <u>isleofmanher.im/</u>

There are also links for the Manx National Heritage collections website iMuseum (imuseum.im) to each War Memorial on the IOMHER.

In accordance with Section 5 (1) of the War Memorials Act 2016 the Council of Ministers may consent to the creation of a war memorial and under Section 5 (2); no person may create a war memorial without such consent. It also stipulates 5 (4) the Council of Ministers must cause the war memorial to be entered in War Memorials Register.

Applications for the creation of a new War Memorial on the Isle of Man should be made in the first instance to the Isle of Man Preservation of War Memorials Committee, the Chair, Mrs Daphne Caine, MHK email: daphne.caine@gov.im or the Secretary email: fenella.evans2@gov.im.

Approval of New Memorials

In February 2022 the Committee received a joint application from the Government of the Republic of Poland and the Polish Airmen's Association UK requesting approval for the erection of two distinct and separate memorials to be erected in the Centenary Garden, Douglas and the Garden of Remembrance at the Aviation and Military Museum, Ronaldsway.

Permission was sought from Douglas Borough Council and the Aviation and Military Museum. The applicants, mindful of the need to ensure the upkeep of the memorials advised they have entered into a contract with a local firm of stonemasons to ensure the ongoing care and maintenance of both memorials.

The Committee were supportive of this venture and recognised the importance of the memorials for the Polish Community both here on the Island and further afield. The Committee put a recommendation to the Council of Ministers under Section 5 (1) of the War Memorials Act requesting approval for the creation of these memorials.

The Council of Ministers agreed at their meeting of 10 February 2022 for the creation of two new war memorials. On the 8 April the memorials were unveiled and ceremony held, at the Centenary Garden, Douglas, with a celebration held afterwards at Government House.

The Committee wish to thank all those involved in the creation of these valuable memorials, and especially note the vital liaison work carried out by Mr Bruce Kirkham, lay member.
