Quit4You Pregnancy Service

The Isle of Man Quit4Two service offers free help and support to pregnant women, family and friends who want to quit smoking.

When you attend your antenatal booking you will be screened for your exposure to carbon monoxide. This simple test takes only a

few seconds and involves blowing into a small tube.

When you smoke a cigarette, the smoke passes from the lungs into your bloodstream. Your blood goes through the placenta and umbilical cord - right into your baby's tiny body.

Carbon monoxide in cigarettes also restricts the oxygen supply, so your baby gets less of the oxygen it needs to grow, and that can affect their development.

Carbon monoxide is in secondhand smoke too. You may be exposed to this at home.

Every time you smoke or breathe in other people's smoke it makes your baby's tiny heart beat harder.

We know that quitting smoking can feel daunting, regardless of whether or not you are pregnant. We can offer confidential, flexible, specialist support and access to free nicotine replacement therapy. We can also support your partner, family or friends too.

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Heating appliances (e.g. gas, oil, coal or wood) need to be checked regularly as fumes from these appliances can also contain large amount of carbon monoxide gas.
