One of my jobs is the Isle of Man's Children's Champion

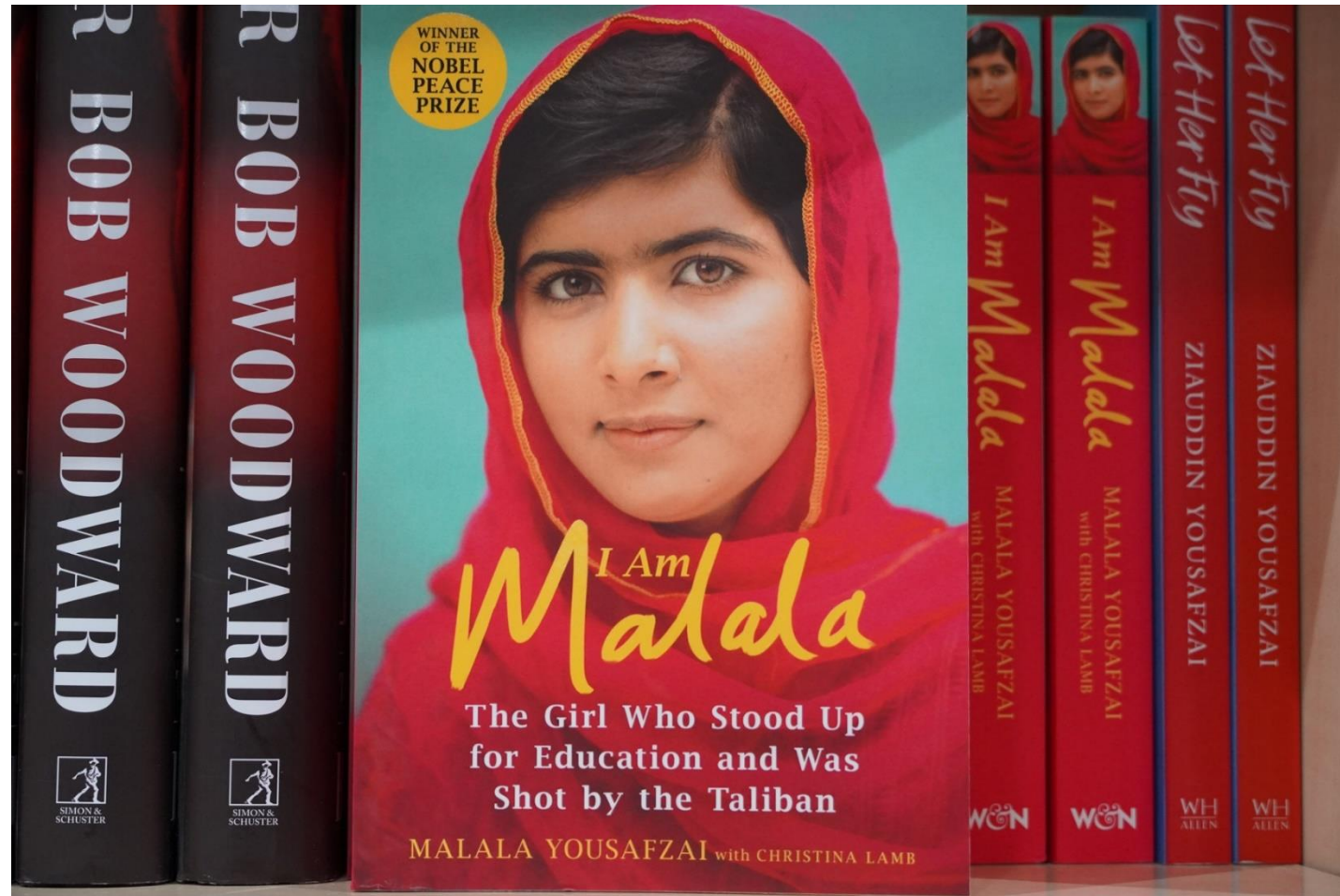
This means that it is my job to teach children about their rights
