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NOTICE TO MARINERS

No. 08 of 2023

Deployment of a Measurement Buoy **Position 54° 19.200'N - 004° 05.400'W**

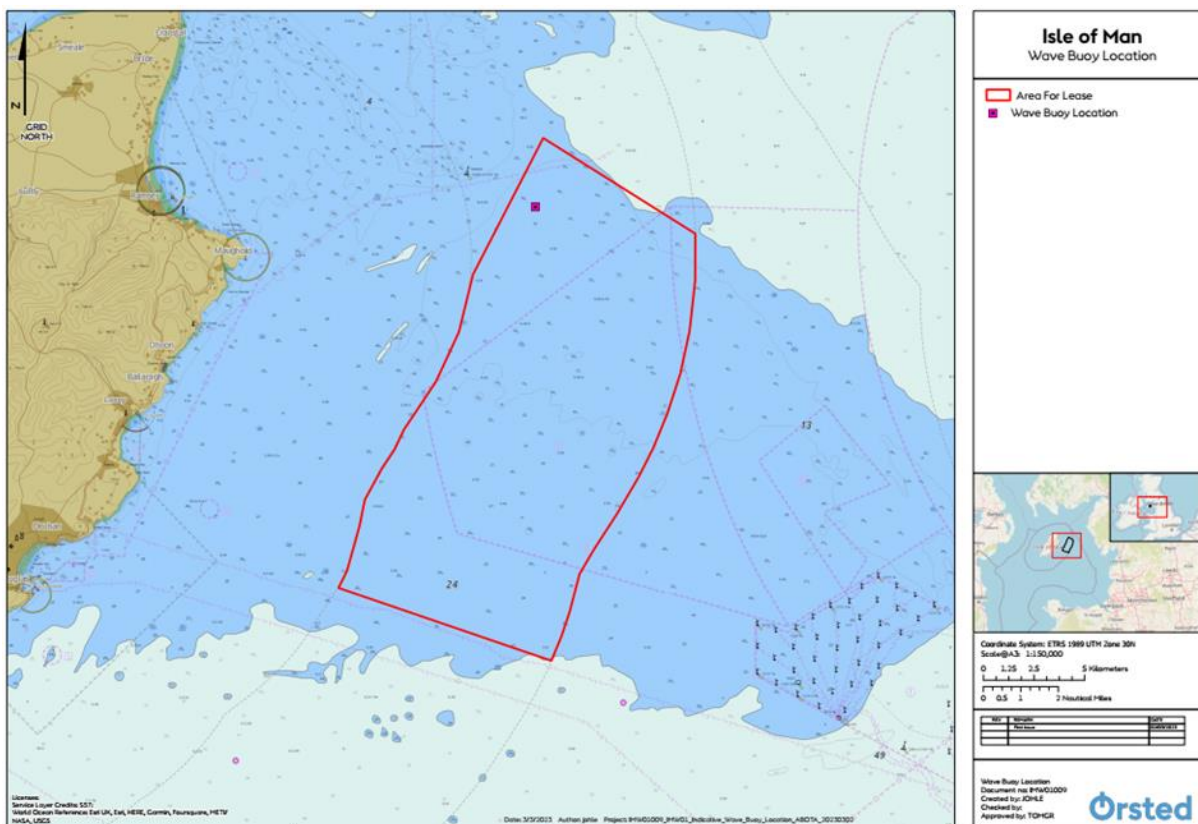


Figure 1 – Buoy Location.

The Harbours Division of the Department of Infrastructure wishes to advise mariners of the deployment of a wave buoy by Orsted Isle of Man (UK) Limited to collect metocean data. The buoy will be deployed on Thursday 24th August and will remain in position for 1 year (Aug 2024). Please see Figure 1 for the location.

The buoy will be equipped with a yellow light Fl.Y.(5) 20s (2.50m above the sea surface), with a range of 3 – 4 nautical miles. The buoy is recognised by its's yellow colour and 'X' topmark.
