



## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

## Restricted Operation of Douglas Road (Millennium) Bridge

The Harbours Division of the Department of Infrastructure wishes to advise mariners that between Monday 5th February to Monday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2024, Douglas Road Bridge will not be available to maneouvre. The flapgate will still be operational, so access in and out of the inner harbour will be possible for small vessels that are able to navigate underneath the bridge.



There will also be a Road Closure Order in place each day between 2000hrs and 0400hrs. The road will remain open outside of these times.

This is to facilitate major maintainence works to replace hydraulic cylinders.
