The Treasury Minister, Hon Dr Alex Allinson MHK – accompanied by CC - has met with the President of the Law Society HM Attorney General's Review of Legal Aid, CC will arrange the publication. The meeting noted that this would require the implementation of a major change programme for Legal Aid and that resources for project management may be required.
