Wreck of FV June Rose

The Harbours Division of the Department of Infrastructure wishes to advise mariners of a new wreck site off the East Coast of the Isle of Man.

On Wednesday 07th February 2024 at 18:50 the Fishing Vessel June Rose PL4 was lost following an incident. The RNLI were in attendance when the vessel sank approximately 4Nm ENE of Clay Head in the following position:

54 12.721N 004 16.445W

The water in the area is 26-30m in depth and the wreck is not buoyed and mariners are advised to exercise extreme caution in the area. Please be aware there may be flotsam in the area.
