

**CIVIL AVIATION (AIRCRAFT REGISTRATION AND MARKING) ORDER 2022
WHO MAY REGISTER AIRCRAFT IN THE ISLE OF MAN**

EXEMPTION

1. The Department for Enterprise (“the Department”), in exercise of its powers under Article 28 of the Civil Aviation (Aircraft Registration and Marking) Order 2022¹ (“the Order”), subject to the conditions set out in paragraphs 2, 3 and 4, exempts persons from the qualified ownership requirements specified in Article 7(1) of the Order.

CONDITIONS

2. The exemption in Paragraph 1 is subject to the following persons holding a legal interest by way of ownership in an aircraft registered in the Isle of Man or in a share in such an aircraft:
 - a. bodies incorporated in or having their registered office, central administration or principal place of business in any of the States or territories listed in paragraph 3; or
 - b. undertakings formed in accordance with the law of and having their registered office, central administration or principal place of business within any of the States or territories listed in paragraph 3.
3. The States or territories referred to in paragraph 2 are:
 - a. Hong Kong (Special Administrative Region);
 - b. Japan;
 - c. People’s Republic of China;
 - d. United States of America.
4. Persons meeting the criteria at paragraphs 2 and 3 shall be considered to be “qualified persons” for the purposes of the Order.

VALIDITY

5. This General Exemption has immediate effect until revoked or suspended.
