Important Information

Land Eligibility:

It is your eligible acreages that are used to calculate your area based payment and the declaration of land eligibility is the responsibility of the applicant. If your eligible acreages are found to be incorrect it may lead to a land eligibility penalty.

Examining the number of Cross Compliance Inspection penalties that were applied and consequently lead to a payment reduction over the last 5 years, an average of 76% of these penalties were land eligibility penalties. These penalties can be avoided if you ensure the information you provide on your Claim Form now is correct.

The size of the eligible area of a field may be caused by trees, coastal erosion, encroachment of scrub, tracks etc. if you have any questions with regards to land eligibility, please contact us.
