SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION ACT 1992 (APPLICATION) (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) ORDER 2022

Approved by Tynwald: 19 October 2022

Coming into Operation in accordance with article 2

The Treasury makes the following Order under section 1(1) of the Social Security Act 2000.

1 Title

This Order is the Social Security Administration Act 1992 (Application) (Amendment) (No.2) Order 2022.

2 Commencement and effect

If approved by Tynwald¹, this Order comes into operation immediately after it is approved by Tynwald, and has effect in respect of the tax year commencing 6 April 2023 and all subsequent tax years.

3 Amendment of the Social Security Administration Act 1992

(1) In section 162 of the Social Security Administration Act 1992 (destination of contributions) —

(a) in subsection (5)(a) for “2.50”, substitute **2.05**; and

(b) in subsection (5)(b) for “2.30”, substitute **1.9**.

For the sake of clarity, the amendments made by paragraphs (a) and (b) have effect despite section 162(8) of the Social Security Administration Act 1992.

(2) In this article references to the Social Security Administration Act 1992 are to that Act of Parliament as it is applied to the Island by the Social Security Administration Act 1992 (Application) Order 1994².

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends the Social Security Administration Act 1992, as it is applied to the Island, by decreasing the percentage of the earnings on which the primary and secondary Class 1 contributions are paid, which are specified in section 162 of that Act and used in calculating the National Health Service allocation from the Manx National Insurance Fund.
