SOCIAL SECURITY LEGISLATION (CATEGORISATION OF EARNERS) (APPLICATION)-(No. 2) ORDER 2012

Approved by Tynwald 10 July 2012
Coming into operation 13 July 2012

The Treasury makes this Order under section 1¹ of the Social Security Act 2000².

- 1 Title**
This Order is the Social Security Legislation (Categorisation of Earners) (Application) (No. 2) Order 2012.
- 2 Commencement**
If approved by Tynwald³, this Order comes into operation on 13 July 2012 and shall have effect in respect of the income tax year commencing 6 April 2012 and all subsequent years⁴.
- 3 Modification of the Social Security (Categorisation of Earners) Regulations 1978 as applied to the Island**
(1) The Social Security (Categorisation of Earners) Regulations 1978⁵, as applied to the Island by the Social Security Subsidiary Legislation (Application) Order 1979⁶ are further modified as follows.

(2) In regulation 1(2) (citation, commencement and interpretation) omit the definition of "educational establishment".

(3) In Part I of Schedule 1 (employments treated as employed earner's employments) –

- (a) in column A omit paragraph 4; and
- (b) in column B omit paragraph 4.

(4) In Schedule 3 (employments in respect of which persons are treated as Secondary Class 1 Contributors) –

- (a) in column A omit paragraph 6; and
- (b) in column B omit paragraph 6.
