

### AGRICULTURAL WAGES ACT 1952

## **AGRICULTURAL WAGES REGULATIONS 2010**

Approved by Tynwald on2010Coming into operation2010

The Agricultural Wages Board makes these Regulations under section 6 of the Agricultural Wages Act 1952¹:-

#### 1 Title

These regulations are the Agricultural Wages Regulations 2010.

#### 2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald<sup>2</sup>, these Regulations shall come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2010.

#### 3 Rents

- (1) The supply of a dwelling for the exclusive occupation of a worker shall, for the purposes of minimum rates of wages to be fixed under the Agricultural Wages Act 1952, be reckoned as payment of wages in lieu of cash in accordance with the following provisions of this regulation.
- (2) The supply of a dwelling shall not be reckoned as payment of wages in lieu of cash unless it consists of a whole house or self-contained accommodation (but not a caravan, mobile home or a building that has been officially declared as unfit for human habitation) that is available to a worker by their contract of employment for the proper or better performance of their duties, and includes any garden that goes with the house.

(3) The cash equivalent of a dwelling shall be calculated in accordance with the following table -

	Weekly Cash
	Equivalent
(a) Dwelling with two bedrooms	£47.73
(b) Dwelling with two bedrooms and a garage	£54.80
(c) Dwelling with more than two bedrooms	£51.49
(d) Dwelling with more than two bedrooms and a garage	£61.98

# 4 Exception

Under no circumstances must deductions in respect of board, lodging or tied accommodation made by an employer result in the wages paid being below that as required by the Minimum Wages Act 2001.

## 5 Revocation

The Agricultural Wages Regulations 2009<sup>3</sup> are revoked.
