THE REDUNDANCY PAYMENTS ACT 1990

THE REDUNDANCY PAYMENTS (STATUTORY COMPENSATION) REGULATIONS 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Industry by sections 35(2) and 45(2) of the Redundancy Payments Act 1990(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Redundancy Payments (Statutory Compensation) Regulations 1990 and, subject to section 45(1) of the Act, shall have effect from the 6th February 1990.
 - (2) In these Regulations -

"the Act" means the Redundancy Payments Act 1990;

"employee" includes any person in respect of whom the Act has effect as if he were an employee.

Abatement or reduction of statutory compensation

- 2. (1) This regulation applies where an employee becomes entitled to a redundancy payment in circumstances in which, on or after 6th February 1990, he also became or becomes entitled to be paid compensation by virtue of section 142 of the Isle of Man Education Act 1949(b).
- (2) The amount of the compensation which would, apart from this Regulation, become due to the employee shall be reduced by the amount of the redundancy payment under the Act which is to be paid to the employee and, in so far as the compensation consists of more than one payment, the payments of such compensation as they become due shall be subject to such abatement or reduction as is necessary to reduce the amount of the compensation by the amount of the redundancy payment.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations provide for the reduction or abatement of compensation for loss of office payable under section 142 of the Isle of Man Education Act 1949 where the employee is also entitled to a redundancy payment.
