
Registered Building (General Regulations) 1982.





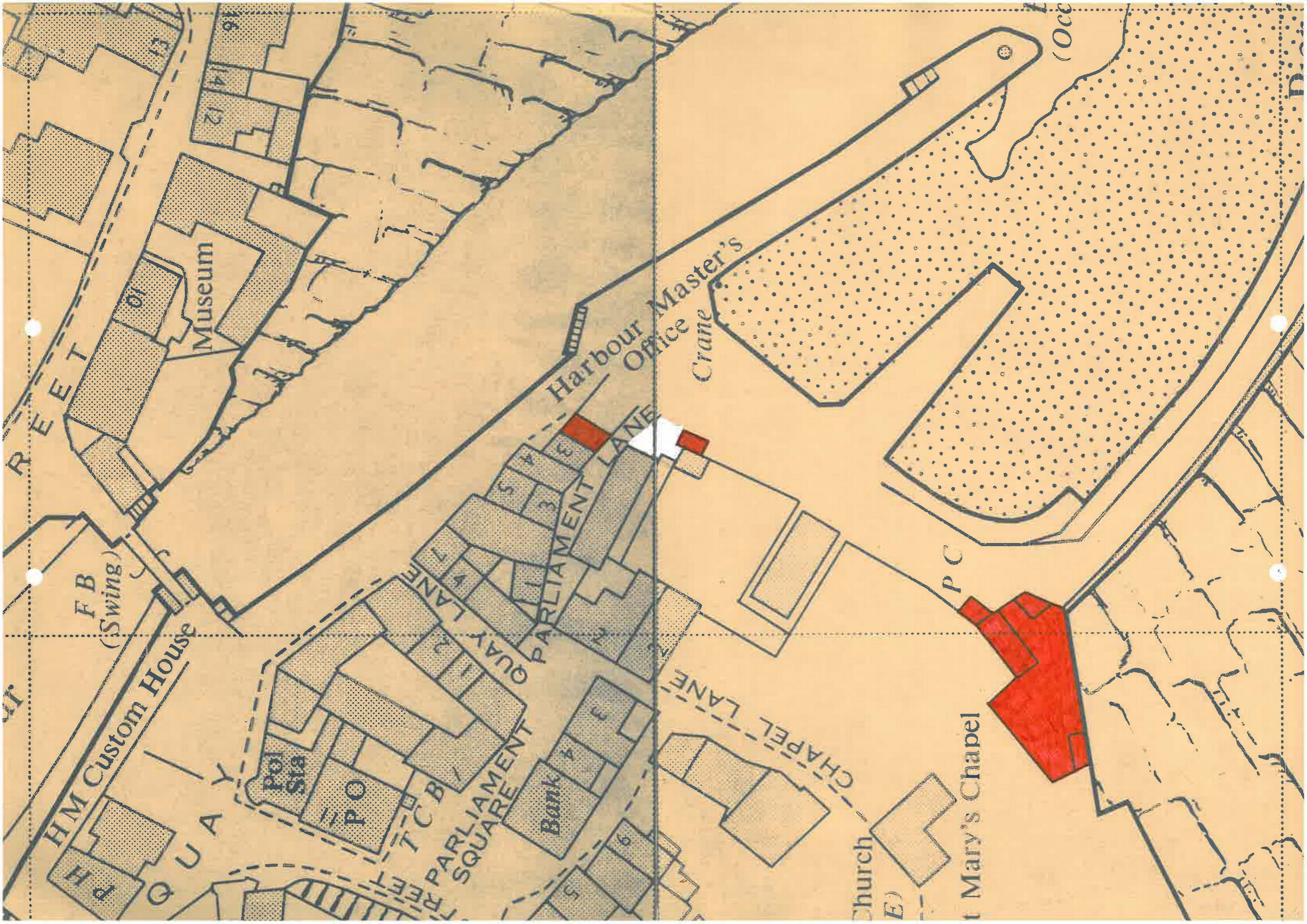
