



LICENSING ACT 1995

LICENSING (EVIDENCE OF AGE) REGULATIONS 2009

Approved by Tynwald 16 December 2009

Coming into operation 01 January 2010

The Department of Home Affairs makes these Regulations under section 23(8) of the Licensing Act 1995¹.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Licensing (Evidence of Age) Regulations 2009.

2 Commencement

These Regulations shall come into operation on 01 January 2010.

3 Evidence of Age

The following are specified as documents which may be produced for the purpose of section 23(7) of the Licensing Act 1995 (evidence of age) –

- (a) a passport;
- (b) a European Union photo card driving licence;
- (c) a student identity card of the design depicted in Schedule 1 which is issued by the Governing body of:
 - (i) Ballakermeen High School;
 - (ii) Castle Rushen High School;
 - (iii) the Isle of Man College;
 - (iv) King William's College;
 - (v) Queen Elizabeth II High School;
 - (vi) Ramsey Grammar School; or

- (vii) St Ninian's High School.
- (d) a card of the design depicted in Schedule 2 which is issued by the Office of Fair Trading;
- (e) a National Identity Card for British Citizens issued by the United Kingdom Identity and Passport Service of the design depicted in Schedule 3;
- (f) an Identification Card for EU or EEA citizens living in the United Kingdom which is issued by the United Kingdom Identity and Passport Service of the design depicted in Schedule 4; or
- (g) a Foreign National Identity Card issued by the United Kingdom Border Agency of the design depicted in Schedule 5.

4 Revocation

The Licensing (Evidence of Age) Regulations 2008² are revoked.

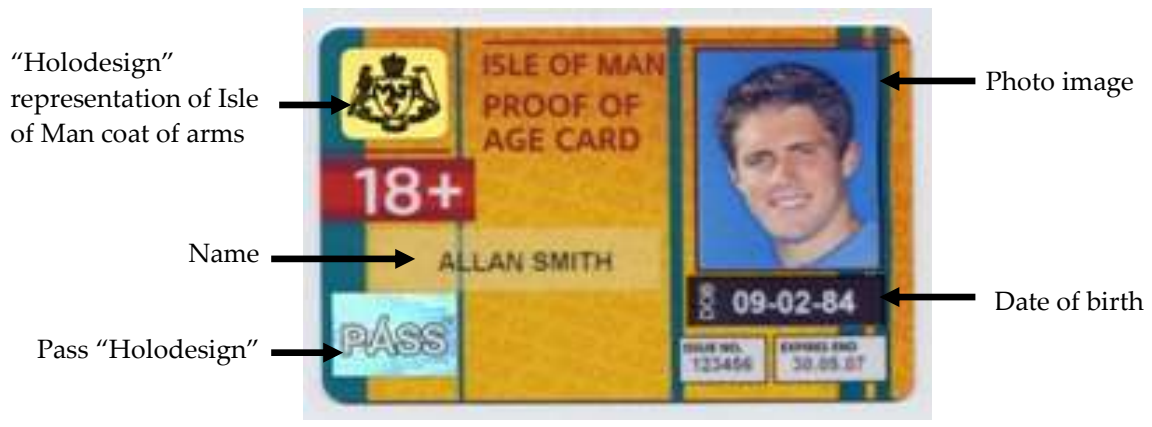

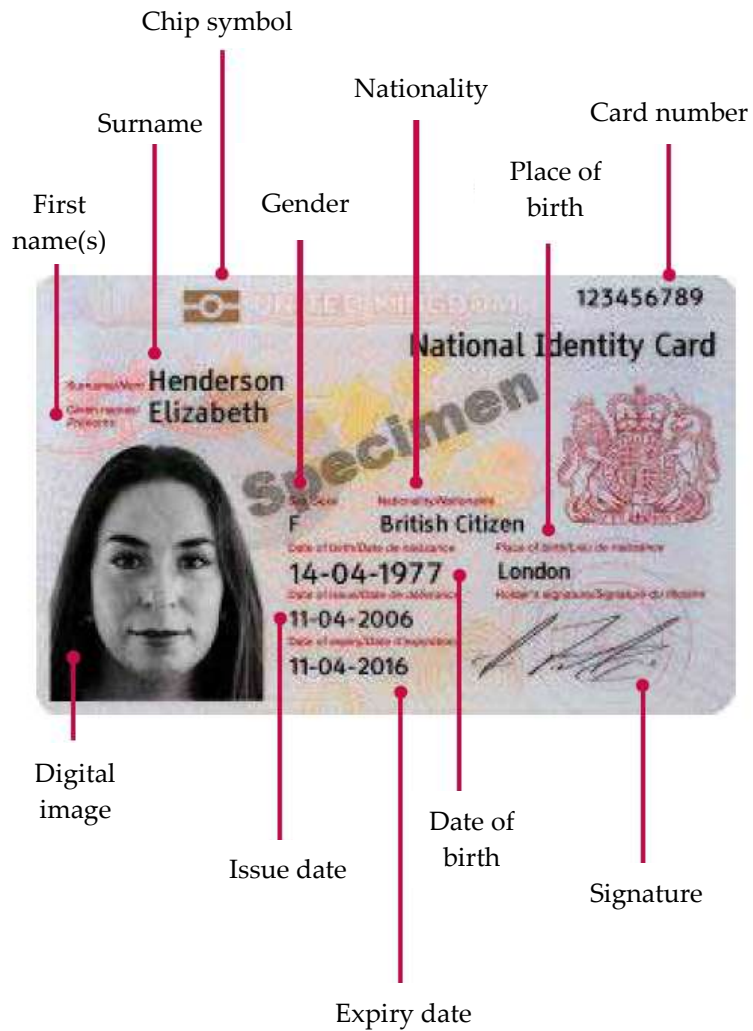

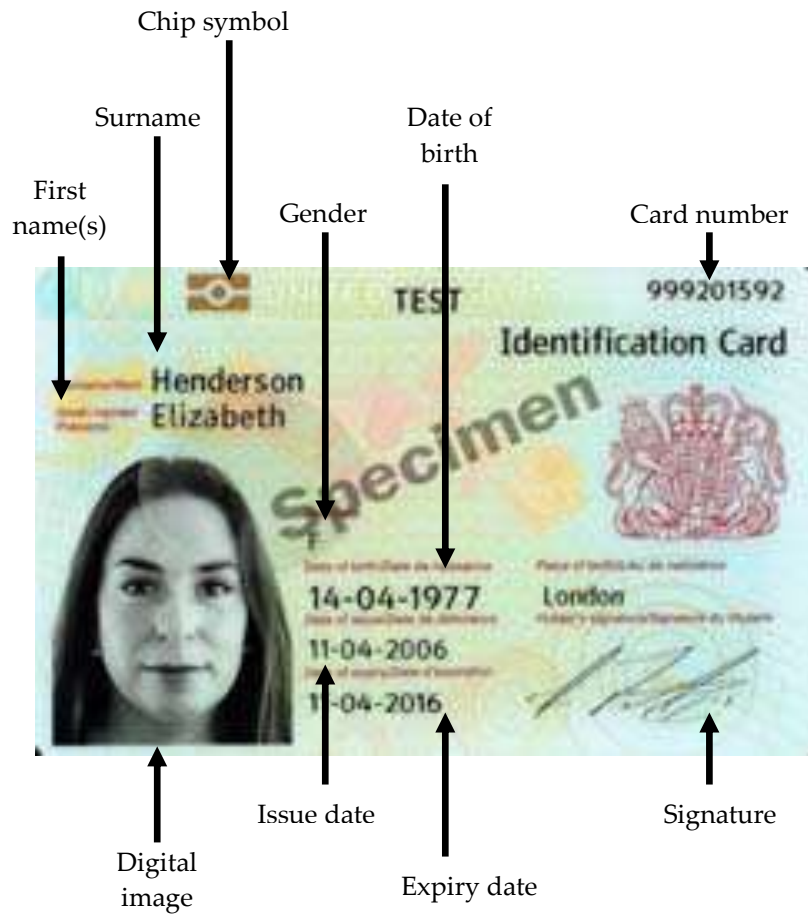

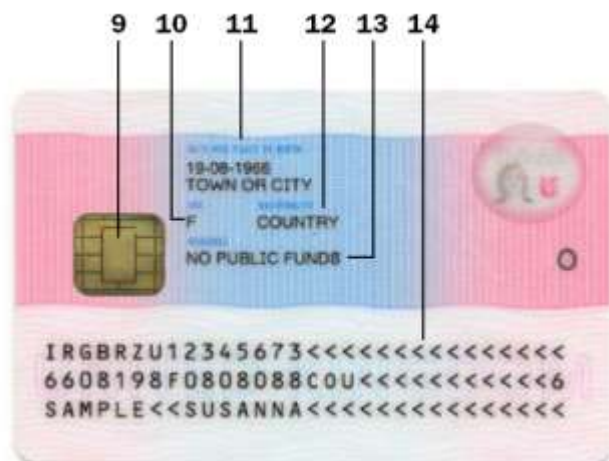
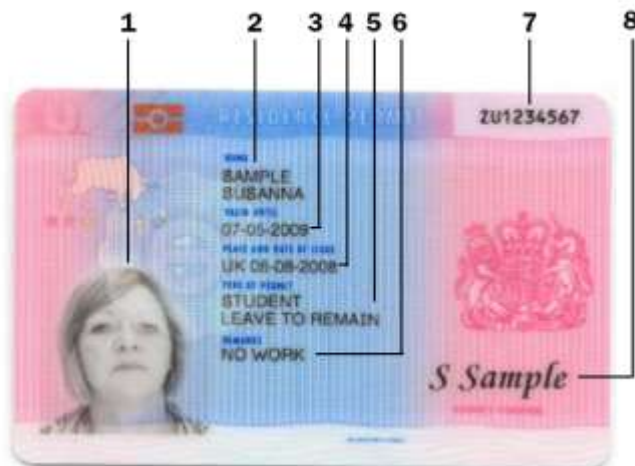
FOREIGN NATIONAL IDENTITY CARD

Front of card

- 4 Place and date of issue
- 5 Type of permit

- 8 Holders signature

Reverse of card

- 9 Biometric chip
- 10 Gender
- 11 Date and place of birth
- 12 Nationality
- 13 Remarks
- 14 Machine readable information



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

These Regulations prescribe the documentation that may be used as evidence of age for the purpose of section 23(7) of the Licensing Act 1995. These regulations make provision for the use of the following documents as evidence of age:

- Passport (of any country);
- European Standard photo card driving licence (including the Isle of Man);
- cards issued by the Isle of Man College, King William's College or any secondary school of the design in Schedule 1;
- a card issued by the Office of Fair Trading of the design set out in Schedule 2;
- A National Identity Card for British citizens issued by the United Kingdom Identity and Passport Service of the design set out Schedule 3;
- An Identification Card for EU/EEA citizens living in the United Kingdom issued by the United Kingdom Identity and Passport Service of the design set out in Schedule 4; or
- A Foreign National Identity Card issued by the United Kingdom Border Agency of the design set out in Schedule 5.

They revoke and replace the Licensing (Evidence of Age) Regulations 2008 [SD536/08] to allow for the addition of National Identity Cards for British citizens; Identification Cards for EU or EEA citizens living in the United Kingdom; and Foreign National Identity Cards to the list of documents suitable as evidence of age.
