



Memorial to the Royal National Lifeboat Institute by Michael Sandle 2002

Commissioned by the Isle of Man Arts Council and sited in the sunken gardens on the Promenade, Douglas. The piece depicts Sir William Hillary and his crew striving to save survivors from the Saint George, wrecked in Douglas Bay in 1830. Unveiled by his Excellency the Lieutenant Governor of the Isle of Man, Air Marshal Ian Macfadyen on 29th June 2002 to mark the 200th Anniversary of the founding of the RNLI.
