COURT FEES ORDER 2011

Approved by Tynwald 18th October 2011

Coming into operation 1 November 2011

The Treasury makes this Order under section 1 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Court Fees Order 2011.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald², this Order comes into operation on 1 November 2011.

3 Court Fees

- (1) For each of the numbered matters set out in the Schedule the fee set out in the final column in respect of each matter shall be chargeable, but subject to paragraph (2).
- (2) If it appears to the Chief Registrar that the payment of any fee specified in the Schedule would, owing to the exceptional circumstances of the particular case or the parties to the case, involve undue hardship, the Chief Registrar may, upon receiving an application to do so, (in the approved form), reduce or remit the fee in that case³.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

- This Order, made under the Fees and Duties Act 1989, replaces the previous Order made in 2010.
- The Order has been amended to incorporate applications under the Civil Partnership Act 2011.
- The opportunity has been taken to address an anomaly whereby it had previously been possible for certain applications to be made to a Court of Summary Jurisdiction rather than the High Court which would not attract a fee and to provide clarification of certain items.
- Government Circular 250/90 (GC 250/90) in relation to the remission of fees pertaining to High Court matters will as a result of this Order be applied to both High Court and Court of Summary Jurisdiction matters where appropriate to resolve a further anomaly
- No changes to existing level of fees are contained within this Order
